FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Now that Lent is upon us, beginning this week with Ash Wednesday, I encourage you to partake in the many opportunities that we are providing for prayer, fellowship, and learning throughout this season:

1. Stations of the Cross each Friday of Lent

2. Soup Supper following Stations on three of those Fridays

3. Lenten Mission which will consist of a series of three talks from March 12-14

4.St. Joseph Table celebration

These are all in addition to the usual times of Eucharistic Adoration and Confession that are regularly available. I am very excited about this Lenten Season. Besides opportunities for us to come together, the above events are tremendous opportunities to invite others, even those who may not be Catholic. I understand that to someone who is not Catholic, or who has not been to Mass in a while, Mass can be intimidating. The above events are all ways we can share some part of our Faith with anyone we know who is interested.

We also have three Catechumens who will be baptized at the Easter Vigil. In the middle of Lent, we will celebrate the Three Scrutinies during the Sunday Mass. These involve special prayers of exorcism which are meant to protect the catechumens from evil and strengthen them in this earthly battle as they make their final preparations for baptism. We are blessed to have them join the Body of Christ in our parish family. I will try to plan to do the Scrutinies at various Masses so everyone can see the catechumens before Easter.

It is important to be reminded of our fasting and abstinence obligations during Lent as well:

-We must abstain from flesh meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent

• This applies to everyone age 14 and older

-We must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday

- This applies to everyone age 18 to 59 inclusive
- Fasting means we can eat one full meal and two other meals may be taken which, when combined, are less than a full meal

There is much to which we look forward in the Easter Season, but first we must pass through the long Lent and prepare our hearts and minds to worthily celebrate that glorious day of Easter. One of the most distinctive features of the Lenten Season is the suppression of the "Alleluia" at Mass. Dom Prosper Guéranger describes what this means for us:

"It was, therefore, necessary that we should be put on our guard against the allurements of our place of exile. It is with this view that the Church, taking pity on our blindness and our dangers, gives us this solemn warning. By taking from us our *Alleluia*, she virtually tells us that our lips must first be cleansed, before they again be permitted to utter this word of angels and saints; and that our hearts, defiled as they are by sin and attachment to earthly things, must be purified by penance. She is going to put before our eyes the sad spectacle of the fall of our first parents, that dire event whence came all our woes, and our need of Redemption. This tender mother weeps over us, and would have us weep with her."

We have a lot of good things going on this season at the parish as we prepare for Easter. We will pray for each other, and please pray for our catechumens, that we all have a holy Lent.

THE SEASON OF LENT BEGINS THIS WEEK, **ASH WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 22**

Traditionally, the Lenten season is a time of penance, prayer, the reception of the sacraments, charity and almsgiving. The following are various Lenten regulations:

Good Friday-along with Ash Wednesday, this is a day of Fast & Abstinence from meat. Everyone between the ages of 18 & 59 inclusive are limited to one full meal on this

All Fridays of Lent—Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence from Meat. All those 14 & up are bound to abstain from

Other Weekdays of Lent-There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial (like giving up something difficult) are recommended.




