RULES OF FAST AND ABSTINENCE DURING LENT

Traditionally, the Lenten season is a time of penance, prayer, the reception of the sacraments, charity and almsgiving. The following are various Lenten regulations:

Good Friday—along with Ash Wednesday, this is a day of Fast & Abstinence from meat. Everyone between the ages of 18 & 59 inclusive are limited to one full meal on this day.

All Fridays of Lent—Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence from Meat. All those 14 & up are bound to abstain from meat.

Other Weekdays of Lent—There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial (like giving up something difficult) are recommended.

PICK OF THE WEEK: Episode 2: Not Perfect, But Chosen

Maybe you've seen it on a bumper sticker: "Christians aren't perfect, just forgiven." There's a lot of truth in that slogan, even if some people misuse it. Nobody's perfect, not even those who profess to follow Jesus. But didn't Jesus tell his followers, "You therefore must be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect" (Matt 5:38)? How can he demand perfection? If Jesus demands perfection of his disciples, you might well give up on the idea of following him before you can even start. Let's take a closer look at what it means to be chosen as a disciple and to become like Jesus.


