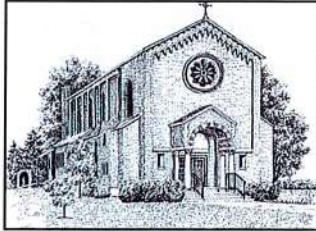

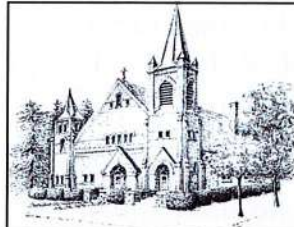

## FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

This coming Saturday, March 25, is the glorious solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord. Exactly nine months before Christmas we celebrate the moment the Archangel Gabriel came to Mary and told her that she is to be the Mother of God. Thankfully, Mary responded, *Fiat mihi secundum verbum tuum* – May it be done to me according to your word. And from that moment on, *God lives with us*. It has always struck me as strange that the Annunciation is not given a higher place, even as a holy day of obligation, in our calendar. Even prior to Christmas, *this is the day God became Flesh and dwelt among us*. Mary thus becomes a living tabernacle, the Ark of the Covenant.

What better way to prepare for such a day as the Annunciation than to honor the great St. Joseph? How could we not honor the Light of the Patriarchs, the Husband of the Mother of God, the Guardian of the Virgin, the Faithful Guardian of Christ, and Head of the Holy Family? Of course, these are just a few of the titles with which we honor him in the Litany of St. Joseph. This year, instead of celebrating the Solemnity of St. Joseph on March 19, it is transferred to Monday, March 20.

As Light of the Patriarchs, he is the fulfillment of the life of Joseph as we read in the Book of Genesis, who was sold into slavery in Egypt, became second-in-command after Pharaoh, and then secured food for the people, including his brothers who sold him. All the biblical patriarchs pointed to Christ. St. Joseph was truly able to hold Him in his arms. St. Joseph took his family into Egypt to secure the life of the infant Jesus, so that this new food, the Bread of Life, could now be given to all the people.

As Head of the Holy Family, we can see the greatness that was bestowed upon St. Joseph. This greatness was not merely his own doing. Abundant graces were poured out upon him, given the magnitude of the task before him, but he also responded perfectly to the promptings of the Holy Spirit within him. Grace builds on nature. As we pray to him as “most chaste” and “most just,” we must realize that such virtues (and all the virtues for that matter) are attainable for us as well. This is why we hold him up as a model for us to follow. He was given a unique role, but he is a man like us, and so able to be imitated in his virtue.

As Head of the Holy Family, his household consisted of the Mother of God (Queen of Angels, Seat of Wisdom, Gate of Heaven, the Immaculate Conception herself, etc.) and the Incarnate Son of God. And yet, as the husband of this Virgin Mother and serving as a father to Christ, both were subject to St. Joseph. “I do not know which excites the more wonder – Mary’s humility or Joseph’s exaltedness. But both are surpassed beyond compare by the child Jesus, who is blessed unto everlasting and yet it is written of Him that He was subject to them: He who created the sun and its uprising was subject to a carpenter; He who to whom every knee must bend in Heaven, on earth and under the earth was subject to a woman working at her loom” (Jean Gerson, Sermon on the Birthday of the Blessed Virgin Mary, preached at the Council of Constance, in 1416; Henri Rondet S.J., *Saint Joseph*, page 68).

Since St. Joseph was given such an exalted role on earth, his place in Heaven is surely most exalted about all the saints, second only to Mary, Queen of All Saints, Angels, and of Heaven. As he was closest to Christ on earth (next to Mary), so he is closest to Christ in Heaven. While we marvel at the many privileges given to St. Joseph, we also seek his intercession. Every morning during my holy hour, I ask St. Joseph for protection for myself, our parish, and our diocese. *Ite ad Joseph*. Go to Joseph for all your needs, as he is a Provider. Go to Joseph for consolation, as he is a Comforter. And go to Joseph for peace and security, as is a Protector.

Glorious St. Joseph, pray for us!

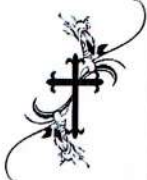

### RULES OF FAST AND ABSTINENCE DURING LENT

Traditionally, the Lenten season is a time of penance, prayer, the reception of the sacraments, charity and almsgiving. The following are various Lenten regulations:

Good Friday—along with Ash Wednesday, this is a day of Fast & Abstinence from meat. Everyone between the ages of 18 & 59 inclusive are limited to one full meal on this day.

All Fridays of Lent—Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence from Meat. All those 14 & up are bound to abstain from meat.

Other Weekdays of Lent—There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial (like giving up something difficult) are recommended.

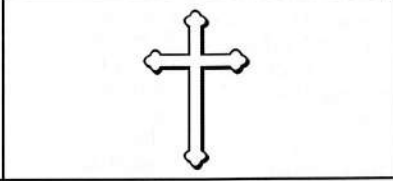
