

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Last week, I gave some basic teaching on the Magisterium of the Church, who makes up this Magisterium, why we have it, and the fact that Christ established it in order to teach in His name. Again, I want to show what the document *Donum Veritatis* teaches about the Magisterium, but this time going into specific types of teachings and the assent that we owe to each.

I want to start at the end this particular section of *Donum Veritatis* by pointing out the role of the Magisterium: "The pastoral task of the Magisterium is one of vigilance. It seeks to ensure that the People of God remain in the truth which sets free" (§20). This is important because we have to realize that the Magisterium does not come up with new revelation. God will not reveal new doctrine, and He has not done so since the death of St. John the Apostle. The Magisterium is there to teach us what is and what is not revealed doctrine and what is compatible with what has been revealed. Living within those boundaries is not oppressive, but rather allows us to be more free and to flourish as we were meant to.

The primary object of the Magisterium's teaching authority is "faith and morals." These are all the things that have been revealed by God (contained within the Deposit of Faith) that we must believe. The theological virtue of Faith is what allows us to know and believe everything God has revealed. These things are declared and taught to us by the Bishops of the world in communion with the Pope (Bishop of Rome). It is also possible for the Pope alone, as Supreme Pastor and Teacher of all Christians, to proclaim a doctrine *ex cathedra*. This term "ex cathedra" means "from the chair," meaning from his office as Successor of St. Peter, the pope can teach infallibly under certain conditions.

Besides truths that are revealed by God, the Magisterium can also teach "in a definitive way." This means that even truths that are not contained directly within the Deposit of Faith, but are necessary to teach in order to protect things that have been revealed, are within the Magisterium's authority. With the previous category, our faith relies on God who has revealed such truths. In this category of teaching, our faith is in the Church's teaching authority, given by God. For example, the Church teaches that various Church councils (Trent, Vatican I, Vatican II) are legitimate councils that teach true doctrine. If this were not true, or at least if the Church did not have the authority to teach such facts, then the faithful would not know where to go for God's true teaching. Truths about the natural law also fall under the infallible teaching authority of the Church.

There is also a third category of teaching where the Church can teach, not in a definitive way, as if teaching revealed doctrine or even something connected to what has been revealed, but further explaining a teaching or issuing disciplinary decrees. Even in these cases, the divine assistance is with the pope when he intends to teach the whole church or enact some discipline. While such teachings or disciplines are not irreformable, we are nevertheless to submit to them. We do believe that there is a type of "security" in the universal pronouncements of the pope, such that we know that we will not be led into sin by his teaching or disciplines. This is a great consolation for us, knowing that we have a secure authority, given to us by God to lead us to heaven.

All of this may seem a bit complicated and unnecessary. The point is that we have an authority on earth that God has given us so that we can know with the certainty of Faith how to get to heaven. We must form the virtue of humility in our souls and, through that humility, come to the obedience that leads us to true peace and Life.


