



FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO


We just celebrated the Epiphany of the Lord and then the Baptism of the Lord on the following day. Since we move the feast of the Epiphany to a Sunday, instead of on the traditional day of January 6 (after the twelfth day of Christmas), that means that Epiphany becomes the First Sunday in Ordinary Time, which is why this Sunday is now the Second Sunday.

So, now this brings us yet again to the beginning of the season of Ordinary Time, as Lent begins in just one month! This season is so called not because it is "ordinary," in the sense of "commonplace" or even "boring," but simply "ordered," in the sense that the weeks are numbered sequentially. A better translation, perhaps, would be "Ordinal Time." This also simply called "per Annum," that is, "throughout the year." This indicates that this is not Lent, Easter, Advent, or Christmas. During this time, we read through the life of Christ, his teachings, miracles, and example so that we learn to imitate Him and so become more His disciple.

Besides "Ordinary Time," in the previous calendar (prior to 1970) we would refer to this time as either "Time after Epiphany" or "Time after Pentecost." I wear the green vestments in both of those seasons, as is still the case, but it is important to notice how the reference is to the great events of God's manifestation on this earth: His presence at the Incarnation, and then His continued presence among us by the Holy Spirit. If we let the *liturgical year shape our life*, we too will come to see our life in relation to these two great mysteries of our Faith and of the life of Christ and His Church – and see everything else in that light.

The Lord is constantly manifesting Himself to us – each time we come to Him in prayer, or receive Him in the Sacraments – there is a sort of epiphany for us. Let us look for those beautiful moments of Our Lord's friendship with us throughout the year!






