






FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Happy Epiphany to you all! We've concluded the "twelve days of Christmas" and now come to the first of the epiphanies ("manifestations") that we read in Scripture of the divinity of Jesus Christ. We know the story from Matthew's Gospel well: the magi, the star, Herod searching for the child. But who were these "magi" and what was this "star" that they followed to Bethlehem?

We often depict the magi in Persian clothing, of different races. Matthew's Gospel, in particular, draws our attention to the fact that the Gentiles (non-Jews) recognized Jesus as the Son of God. These depictions in art remind us that God has called all people to come into his family, and so to worship Him as the true God. In our days, every corner of the earth has heard the name of Christ, but the fact of all the nations are called to Christ started right there in Bethlehem.

These "magi" were men who used astrological signs to interpret world events. They would see the alignment of stars and planets, in this case, and know that a new king had been born. So, these magi "from the east," whoever they were, saw themselves as worthy to go visit a newborn king, and to bring expensive gifts. Naturally, they go to the royal house, expecting to find the heir to the throne at Herod's palace. Of course, this is not the case, and so the magi are told that the ruler would come from Bethlehem.

How exactly did they know to begin with, and what were they following? Some have speculated that the "star" was actually the planet Jupiter. Jimmy Akin, from Catholic Answers, tells us this: "One of the most interesting of these events was the rising of Jupiter and Venus on August 12, 3 B.C. Since Babylonian times, Jupiter was seen as a heavenly king, and Venus was seen as a heavenly queen, suggesting a birth. Furthermore, the Babylonians named Regulus (the brightest star in [the constellation] Leo) 'the king,' and the lion was a traditional symbol of the tribe of Judah (cf. Gen. 49:9)." None of this is to approve of astrology, however. What we see here, if this interpretation of events is correct, is God meeting these Magi where they are and bringing them to Himself. Of course He can reveal Himself through the stars! He made them! For us, we have been given the definitive revelation of Jesus Christ, handed on to us by the Church. We do not use stars or planets to tell us where to find the King. He reigns from our altars, in our tabernacles, and He is happy to receive us whenever we come to Him.




