



#### FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

I was recently asked about one of the prayers in the Roman Canon, after the Consecration, where the priests bow low to the altar and says:

"In humble prayer we ask you, almighty God: command that these gifts be borne by the hands of your holy Angel to your altar on high in the sight of your divine majesty, so that all of us who through this participation at the altar receive the most holy Body and Blood of your Son may be filled with every grace and heavenly blessing."

Two years ago I did a series of bulletin articles on each prayer of the Roman Canon (Eucharistic Prayer I), but these things are worth reviewing because every prayer within the Roman Canon is rich with biblical imagery.

The Book of Revelation shows us the heavenly liturgy as seen by St. John: "Another angel came and stood at the altar, holding a gold censer. He was given a great quantity of incense to offer, along with the prayers of all the holy ones, on the gold altar that was before the throne. The smoke of the incense along with the prayers of the holy ones went up before God from the hand of the angel" (8:3-4). What we see here is that the angels have a mediatorial role between this earthly altar in our church and the altar in heaven where God is worshipped directly at His throne.

With this offering we give all that we are and have in our being to God. But the gift of infinite value that is before me is the Eucharistic Sacrificial Body and Blood of Christ. And so the priest asks this "Angel" who is perfectly pure, who sees God already in heaven, to take this offering before His Majesty so that it may be acceptable. St. John Chrysostom (4<sup>th</sup> century bishop) tells us: "The priest is himself at that solemn moment surrounded by angels, and the choir of the heavenly Powers unite with him; they occupy the entire space around the altar, to honor Him who lies there as a Sacrifice" (*Of the Priesthood*, VI, 4).

But then the question is: But who is this Angel? Do we know his name? There is no definitive answer on this, but multiple opinions have been given. It may be the guardian angel of the particular church or altar, of even of the priest himself (and of his priesthood). Some say it is St. Michael who is the guardian of the Eucharist and of the Church Militant (the Church here on earth). Or the term "Angel" may simply signify all the angels who assist us at each liturgy. Whatever it may be, what we find in this prayer is the union between what we are doing on earth, and what is happening eternally in heaven: The worship of God by all His creation, visible and invisible.

Finally, the prayer concludes with the priest signing himself with the Sign of the Cross (the older Mass included the priest kissing the altar as well, prior to the Sign of the Cross). This signifies the superabundance of blessings and grace that flow from Heaven (having accepted the Sacrifice), to the priest, and through his ministry at the altar, to the whole congregation.

All of this is due to the one Mediator, perfect God and perfect Man, reigning at the right hand of the Father, the fountain of all grace. And so we conclude that prayer: Through Christ our Lord. Amen.




