

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

As I have been on the *Ask a Priest Live* show several times now, I have seen a lot of questions come by, many of which we do not get to answer. How it works is that sometime on the morning of the show, the producer will send out a live Google Document – "live" means that anyone can edit it in real time and everyone who has the link can see it – with emailed questions. Last week, the document contained about 45 pages of emails. The font is rather large, but that is a lot of emails, and the list keeps growing. Phone calls take precedence in the show since those are more interactive and make the show more interesting than simply reading emails, as good as the questions may be.

I figured if people around the country and the world have questions, then you may have similar questions and interests. I looked back at the list of emailed questions and found a question about resources to study Scripture. It can be daunting to just simply open the Bible and start reading and then have questions, not knowing where to go for solid resources to help you understand.

These days, there are several very good, accurate resources that will help you read Scripture. Of course, nothing substitutes for real prayer, meditation upon God's Word. Studying the Scriptures in an intellectual way is great, but we also must pray with the Scriptures and let God's Word form us.

For example, Ascension Press publishes *The Great Adventure Catholic Bible*, besides the *Bible in a Year* study. They also publish *The Bible Compass* which offers a guide to reading, understanding, and contemplating the Scriptures.

If you are looking for something with detailed notes and explanation for every part of the New Testament, I personally use the *Ignatius Catholic Study Bible* for this reason. It makes connections with Old Testament precedents as well as references to Church Fathers and their interpretations.

If you are looking for more interactive content, try the *Emmaus Academy* at St. Paul Center for Biblical Theology. They have full courses on all aspects of Scripture, taught by Dr. Scott Hahn and Dr. John Bergsma. There is currently a free trial being offered right now.

Our parish also has a subscription to Formed.org. We reference *Formed* in our bulletin each week, and so it is a good time to finally see all of the great offerings that it has that we already pay for! For example, at the top of the page, under the 'Programs' tab, there is a page for 'Bible Studies.' You will find there high quality Catholic content to help you delve deeper in the Word of God and come to a greater appreciation of the Scriptures. Besides, the Church's year is coming to an end next week and a new year is beginning on the First Sunday of Advent. It is a good time to make a New Year's Resolution to continue to develop our intellectual and spiritual life and take advantage of the excellent resources available to us.




