



FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

As we come now to the Third Sunday of Advent, the rose vestments are worn to signal to us that something is different. The violet vestments speak to us of penance, while the rose vestments lighten the mood for us as the Lord is near.

In fact, we hear these very words in today's *Introit* (Entrance Antiphon) that is chanted at the beginning of the Mass: "Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice! For the Lord is near." We refer to this Sunday as "Gaudete" Sunday because the first words of the Mass, as given in the Entrance Antiphon, in Latin, are: "Gaudéte in Dómino semper: íterum dico, gaudéte. Dóminus enim prope est." The Church calls us to rejoice because the Lord whom we have so longed for is about to come again, and the joy and peace that we know at Christmas will hopefully come to us again this season.

There is also a great tradition on this Third Sunday of Advent. In Italy, children would have a little figure of the Christ Child that would go in the manger, called the "Bambinelli." They would make a trip to Rome to St. Peter's Square and the Holy Father blessed the Bambinelli, the children, and their families. Here is a prayer that can be prayed around your own manger scene, and should be prayed by the father in each home:

God our Father, you loved us so much you sent us your only Son, Jesus, born of the Virgin Mary, to save us and lead us back to you.

We pray that, with your blessing, these images of Jesus might be a sign of your presence and love in our homes.

Good Father, give your blessing to all who gather with us this Christmas, family and friends.

Open our hearts, that we might receive Jesus in joy, always do what He asks of us, and see Him in those who need our love. Amen.

Finally, as next Sunday is both the Fourth Sunday of Advent and Christmas Eve, I wanted again to give you the five options for next weekend's Masses.

Remember, the Mass at St. Dominic, 12:00pm, December 24, is cancelled

Given that there are two obligations to fulfill, here are all the ways that you can fulfill both obligations throughout the weekend:

- 1. Saturday evening (4:00pm) and Sunday evening (4:00pm)
- 2. Saturday evening (4:00pm) and Monday morning (12:00am, 10:00am)
- 3. Sunday morning (8:00am, 10:00am) and Sunday evening (4:00pm)
- 4. Sunday morning (8:00am, 10:00am) and Monday morning (12:00am, 10:00am)
- 5. Sunday evening (4:00pm) and Monday morning (12:00am, 10:00am)

Be assured of my continued prayers for you and for your intentions each day as we together prepare for the coming of the Lord on the glorious feast of Christmas.
