






FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Last week I said I would begin going through parts of Fr. Jacques Philippe's book *Searching for and Maintaining Peace*. I do not have a plan already figured out, but I will summarize each section with helpful quotations as I read through the book.

The first section is entitled, "Without Me, You Can Do Nothing." One of the essential truths of the spiritual life that we have to learn, and one we must be constantly reminded of, is the fact that we really are nothing. On Ash Wednesday, as the ashes are imposed on your forehead, you will hear the words, "Remember that you are dust, and unto dust you shall return." This is not said to us so that we can be scared and depressed about life and death. It is said to us so that, with this truth, we can then ask, "So where do I go and what do I do?" The answer is then given to us in the Gospel of John (15:5): "Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, *because without me you can do nothing.*" It is not that we can do *something* or even *a little*, but that we can do *nothing* without Christ or apart from Him.

We cannot exist even for a moment apart from His will, and we certainly cannot save ourselves and attain heaven without His grace. We may know this on an intellectual level, but at some point we have to come to know this on a much deeper level, on the level of our very being. We may have moments in our life when we are very desperate spiritually, desolated, and we know then that it is only God to whom we can turn for any consolation and peace. Even when we sin, it is then that we need to realize that this is because we have not yet relied on God entirely.

Fr. Philippe shows that it is only by having an interior peace, peace in our hearts, that we can let God do His work in us, and that His work will bear fruit. Fr. Philippe gives a good image as to what this looks like:

"In order to understand this, we can use an image (without exaggerating, as we should always avoid doing in making comparisons); but one that can be illuminating. Consider the surface of a lake, above which the sun is shining. If the surface of the lake is peaceful and tranquil, the sun will be reflected in the lake; and the more peaceful the lake, the more perfectly will it be reflected. If, on the contrary, the surface of the lake is agitated, undulating, then the image of the sun can not be reflected in it" (page 5).

Of course, the questions continue. How, then, do we acquire this interior peace and maintain this peace? How do we make that lake calm so that God's light, His grace, can work in us? An indispensable element of this peace that we so desire is simply prayer. Without regular, daily communication with God in prayer, we cannot recognize our frailty and failings, and so cannot receive healing. We want life. We want God's life to shine out through us.

I pray that you have a peaceful, and penitential Ash Wednesday (day of fasting and abstinence) and that this Lenten Season leads us all to a greater fervor and love of the Passion of Our Lord.

THE SEASON OF LENT BEGINS THIS WEEK, ASH WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 14

Traditionally, the Lenten season is a time of penance, prayer, the reception of the sacraments, charity and almsgiving. The following are various Lenten regulations:

Good Friday-along with Ash Wednesday, this is a day of fast & abstinence from meat. Everyone between the ages of 18 & 59 inclusive are limited to one full meal on this day.

All Fridays of Lent-Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. All those 14 & up are bound to abstain from meat.

Other Weekdays of Lent—There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended (like giving up something difficult.)




