



FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Holy Week is upon us. This is the most profoundly beautiful time of year that the Church gives to us, where all the Mysteries of our Faith come before our eyes as we re-live those final days of Our Lord's life on this earth. Here, we will go to the Last Supper again with Christ and His Apostles.

During this week, we see the Institution of the Most Holy Eucharist, the source and summit of our life of faith, our Bread that feeds us for eternal life, a foretaste of Heaven. Along with this Institution, and inseparable from it, is the Priesthood. If Christ instituted an everlasting Sacrifice in the Most Holy Eucharist, then He also established a Priesthood, which is nothing else than the participation in the one Priesthood of Jesus Christ. Priesthood and sacrifice are inseparable. A priesthood without a sacrifice to offer makes no sense. And so Our Lord told His Apostles to "Do This in Memory of Me," and then showed them, and all the world, for all time, what this entails. On Good Friday we then go to the Cross with Christ as He inaugurates the New and Eternal Covenant in Himself.

The silence of the evening of Good Friday and all day on Holy Saturday is broken only by the solemn proclamation of the Resurrection of Christ by the chanting of the *Exsultet*. Thus, everything is changed, and death has been conquered. Eternal life is offered to us and this Life, Life Itself, has a face and a name: Jesus Christ. Our life only makes sense, it has its ultimate meaning in the life of Christ.

Enjoy these coming days, these final days of Lent and the glorious celebration of Easter, as we continue to strive to conform ourselves more fully to our Crucified and Risen Lord.

Finally, I want to express my deep gratitude to all who helped prepare the St. Joseph's Table celebration. It was incredibly successful yet again, and everyone who prepared the Parish Center, and especially the amazing food, went above and beyond yet again. Seeing our parishioners, and so many children, especially, all together for this celebration is a beautiful witness to our community of our life of faith.


