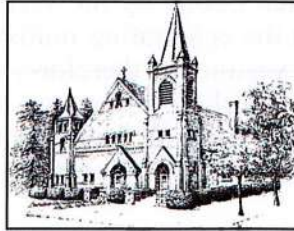

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

We had a glorious Divine Mercy Sunday celebration with Adoration, many confessions, and singing of the Divine Mercy Chaplet. It was a fitting end to the Easter Octave and beginning of this Easter Season. With all of the beauty of our churches and the vestments that I wear, I wanted to share with you something that most people do not see, that is, the ritual involved with the priest getting vested for Mass.

On EWTN's website, you can find an article by Fr. Mauro Gagliardi on "Liturgical Vestments and the Vesting Prayers." The vestments not only have, or had, some practical function, depending on the vestment, but they also take on a symbolic meaning related to the role of the priest. Gagliardi tells us this:

"Furthermore, the ample form of the vestments, the alb, for example, the dalmatic and the chasuble, put the individuality of the one who wears them in second place in order to emphasize his liturgical role. One might say that the 'camouflaging' of the minister's body by the vestments depersonalizes him in a way; it is that healthy depersonalization that de-centers the celebrating minister and recognizes the true protagonist of the liturgical action: Christ. The form of the vestments, therefore, says that the liturgy is celebrated '*in persona Christi*' [in the person of Christ] and not in the priest's own name. He who performs a liturgical function does not do so as a private person, but as a minister of the Church and an instrument in the hands of Jesus Christ. The sacred character of the vestments also has to do with their being donned according to what is prescribed in the Roman Ritual."

And so, here are the prayers that I pray before every Mass as I "put on Christ" to celebrate the Mass:

While he washes his hands

Give strength to my hands, Lord, to wipe away all stain, so that I may be able to serve Thee in purity of mind and body.

As he places the Amice over his head

Lord, set the helmet of salvation on my head to fend off all the assaults of the devil.

As he puts on the Alb

Purify me, Lord, and cleanse my heart so that, washed in the Blood of the Lamb, I may enjoy eternal bliss.

As he ties the Cincture

Lord, gird me with the cincture of purity and extinguish my fleshly desires, that the virtue of continence and chastity may abide within me.

As he puts the maniple on his left arm

May I deserve, O Lord, to bear the maniple of weeping and sorrow in order that I may joyfully reap the reward of my labors.

As he puts the Stole around his neck

Lord, restore the stole of immortality, which I lost through the prevarication of our first parents, and, unworthy as I am to approach Thy sacred mysteries, may I yet gain eternal joy.

As he puts on the Chasuble

O Lord, who has said, 'My yoke is sweet and My burden light,' grant that I may so carry it as to merit Thy grace. Amen.

You can see how in each of the prayers there is a desire expressed to be more conformed to Christ in whose Name I offer the Mass. It is a constant reminder of who I am and why I was made. Thanks be to God for giving us His Crucified and Risen Son who continues His most loving Presence in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Altar!

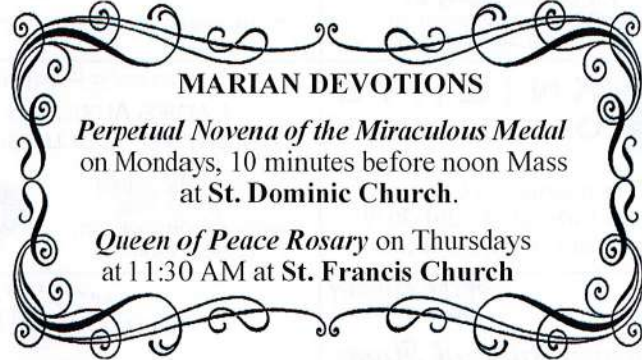
