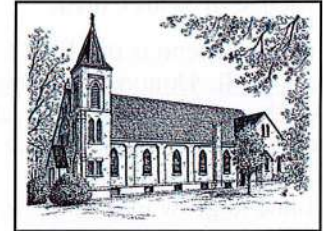

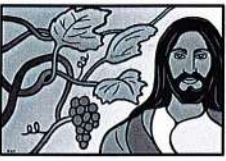

# Month One: DEVELOPING BABY

## Spiritual Adoption Program 2024

From April 8 to December 25  
(Feast of the Annunciation to Christmas)

*Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you. Jeremiah 1:5*
