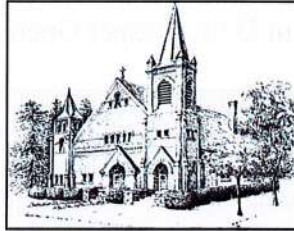

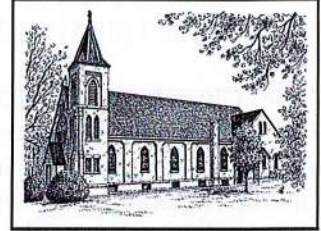

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Happy Easter! He is Risen! Alleluia! Alleluia!

On this Octave Day of Easter, also called Divine Mercy Sunday, we continue to celebrate the Resurrection of Christ, and our celebration is carried on for 50 days. Last week I wrote a little about the Divine Mercy devotion and the graces offered on that day. I just want to again encourage people to attend, bring your friends, and come pray with us on this beautiful feast day, starting at 1:30pm on Sunday.

Again, I cannot adequately express my gratitude for all that people have done to make our churches and our liturgies beautiful throughout the Easter Triduum and the Easter Sunday Masses. They were all so glorious and worthy of the honor and worship due to God for what He has done for us. As you take a look at the pictures of our beautifully decorated churches, I give you these words from Dom Prosper Guéranger, O.S.B.:

“The Church would, therefore, have us consider ourselves as having already risen with our Jesus, and as having already taken possession of eternal life. The holy Fathers bid us look on these fifty days of Easter as the image of our eternal happiness. They are days devoted exclusively to joy; every sort of sadness is forbidden; and the Church cannot speak of her divine Spouse without joining to her words that glorious cry of heaven, the *Alleluia*, wherewith, as the holy Liturgy says, the streets and squares of the heavenly Jerusalem resound without ceasing.

We have been forbidden the use of this joyous word during the past [six] weeks; it behooved us to die with Christ – but now that we have risen together with him from the tomb, and that we are resolved to die no more that death which kills the soul and caused our Redeemer to die on the cross, we have a right to our *Alleluia*.”
