




# FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Happy Easter! The Lord is Risen! Alleluia!!! Alleluia!!!

I pray that the Lenten Season now passed will bear fruit in the glorious Easter Season now upon us. After going with our Lord to His Last Supper, to Gethsemane, to Golgotha, to the Tomb, and waiting for Him...we are refreshed and we rejoice that the Tomb is empty, Death is conquered, Life restored!

The liturgical seasons, as the natural seasons, bring about changes and shifting emphases as we go about the year. As this is my second time through the seasons with you, I see how that looks more clearly. While the natural seasons do not have such a hard line of transition between winter and spring, for example, as do the liturgical seasons between Lent and Easter, we know that every ending transitions to a new beginning. In my own capacity as teacher/catechist, we are preparing for the final classes of Confirmation preparation (Confirmation will be May 11, at St. Mary's in Canandaigua). At the same time, we are about to begin First Communion classes (First Communion will be May 21, 12:00pm) to prepare our children for that special moment when they receive our Lord, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity for the first time into their own body and soul. The same Lord who walked out of the tomb on this day, they will be so privileged to receive for the first time.

As Spring then fades into Summer, we go from celebrating Confirmation and First Communion, to celebrating *Corpus Christi*, and the preparation that goes into next year's Faith Formation...but I am getting ahead of myself. We should not let this time pass us by, simply looking to get the next thing done. The mystery of Easter – the whole season, but most especially this octave – is worth contemplating even more so than Lent, as our redemption is now accomplished and we are reconciled with God through the very flesh of Christ, Crucified and Risen.

Again, Dom Prosper Guéranger summarized this glorious day and season for us:

"The human race was dead; it was the victim of that sentence, whereby it was condemned to lie mere dust in the tomb; the gates of life were shut against it. But see! The Son of God rises from His grave and takes possession of eternal life. Nor is He the only one that is to die no more, for as the Apostle teaches us, 'He is the first-born from the dead' (Colossians 1:18). The Church would, therefore have us consider ourselves as having already risen with our Jesus, and as having already taken possession of eternal life. The holy Fathers bid us look on these fifty days of Easter as the image of our eternal happiness. They are days devoted exclusively to joy; every sort of sadness is forbidden; and the Church cannot speak to her divine Spouse without joining to her words that glorious cry of heaven, the *Alleluia*, wherewith, as the holy Liturgy says, the streets and squares of the heavenly Jerusalem resound without ceasing. We have been forbidden the use of this joyous word during [Lent]; it behooved us to die with Christ – but now that we have risen together with Him from the tomb, and that we are resolved to die no more that death which kills the soul and caused our Redeemer to die on the cross, we have a right to our *Alleluia*."

Alleluia! May God abundantly bless you and your families during this most joyous Easter Season.
