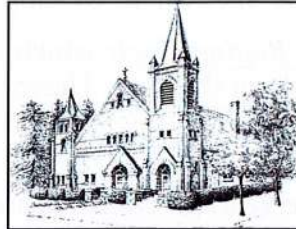

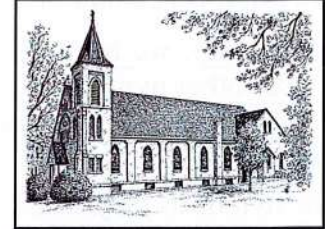

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Again, I want to congratulate all the First Communicants from last weekend. They worked hard to prepare for that important moment in their lives and even though some were very nervous to approach the steps of the altar, they all did so well and we are proud of them. Thank you, as well, to our catechists who spent so much time in preparation for this First Communion.

I mentioned last weekend about the various Marian antiphons (or hymns) that are sung throughout the year. The Divine Office – the Liturgy of the Hours – is a type of liturgical prayer that priests and deacons have to pray, but everyone is encouraged to pray it. It consists largely of the Psalms and various readings from Scripture. The idea is that each part of the day is punctuated by prayer, whatever we happen to be doing. For example, in a monastery, their life consists of prayer and work (*ora et labora*), and so they rise very early in the morning for Matins, then Lauds (Morning Prayer), and then mid-morning, midday, mid-afternoon, Vespers (Evening Prayer), and Compline (Night Prayer). Each of the “hours” has its own “feel” to it as the day progresses (and as the week progresses), but it is at Compline, the close of the day, where we sing the various Marian antiphons.

At the end of Mass, we have been singing the *Regina Caeli* which is the hymn used during the Easter Season. There are three other hymns that we sing throughout the year. These hymns are not just part of a music repertoire, they are part of our *culture* as Catholics. We sing such hymns simply because it is always good to call your Mother.

Here are the hymns as they come throughout the year, given in a more literal translation. There are other translations that keep a rhyme, and you can find various versions set to music. From Advent until February 1 (which is the eve of *Candlemas*, the Feast of the Purification, the traditional end of the Christmas Season) we sing the *Alma Redemptoris Mater*:

Holy mother of our Redeemer, thou gate leading to heaven and star of the sea; help the falling people who seek to rise, thou who, all nature wondering, didst give birth to thy holy Creator. Virgin always, hearing the greeting from Gabriel's lips, take pity on sinners.

From February 2 until Wednesday of Holy Week we sing the *Ave Regina Caelorum*:

Hail, queen of heaven, hail lady of the angels. Hail, root, hail the door through which the Light of the world is risen. Rejoice, glorious Virgin, beautiful above all. Hail, O very fair one, and plead for us to Christ.

From Easter Sunday through Pentecost we sing the *Regina Caeli*:

Queen of heaven, rejoice, alleluia; for He whom thou was chosen to bear, alleluia; has risen as He said, alleluia; pray for us to God, alleluia.

Finally, after Pentecost all the way until Advent, we sing the *Salve Regina*, certainly the most familiar to all of us:

Hail holy queen, mother of mercy, hail our life, our sweetness, and our hope. To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this vale of tears. Turn then most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy towards us. And after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, o loving, o sweet Virgin Mary.

As we come to the end of this month of May, take some time to familiarize yourself with these hymns. Many different versions can be found in melodies and Gregorian tones. It is always a good idea to get more in touch with our traditional hymns, but especially when it comes to our devotion to Mary. In the upcoming month of June, we honor the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, the well-spring of all virtue, the King and center of all hearts.

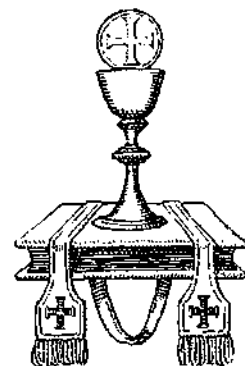

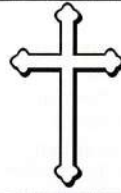
