FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

As we approach the month of July, a month traditionally dedicated to devotion to the Most Precious Blood of Christ, we come upon yet another beautiful month dedicated to such a crucial aspect of our Faith. We held May in honor of Mary, June in honor of the Most Sacred Heart, and now July in a particular way we show devotion to the Precious Blood. Some of the history of this day is important. There was a feast celebrated in Spain in the 16th century, but it was not extended to the whole Church until the 19th century. The history is quite interesting and shows how much our liturgical observance can be bound up with the historical circumstances of our pilgrim Church, directed by God's loving Providence.

In 1848, Pope Pius IX was still the sovereign of the Papal States, which covered central Italy. Then, a group of rebels called the Roman Republic briefly took over as Pius IX went into exile in Gaeta in The Kingdom of the Two Sicilies. His companion with him was the superior general of the Fathers of the Most Precious Blood. (The Most Precious Blood Fathers were serving in our own diocese as well. They served Most Precious Blood Church in the city of Rochester when I was baptized there.) On June 30, 1849, the French army conquered Rome again and it was free.

Pius IX returned to Rome on July 2 – at that time, the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary – and honored Mary for the victory just as Pius V had done after the battle of Lepanto (1571). But later, Pius IX established the Feast of the Most Precious Blood. He knew the care of Christ's Church on earth had been given to him, and it was for her, the Church, that Our Lord shed His blood.


After just celebrating Easter, Pentecost, and Corpus Christi, we know that the mystery of our redemption cannot be exhausted, and so in a particular way we meditate on the Blood of Our Lord. Prior to 1970, this feast was celebrated on July 1. For a meditation on this feast, again we turn to Dom Prosper Guéranger:

"The peace which this Blood has made to reign in the high places as well as in the low; the impetus of its wave bearing back the sons of Adam from the yawning gulf, purified, renewed and dazzling white in the radiance of their heavenly apparel; the sacred Table outspread before them on the waters' brink, and the chalice brimful of inebriation – all this preparation and display would be objectless, all these splendors would be incomprehensible, if man were not brought to see therein the wooings of a love that could never endure its advances to be outdone by the pretensions of any other. Therefore, the Blood of Jesus is set before our eyes at this moment as the Blood of the Testament; the pledge of the alliance proposed to us by God; the dower stipulated by eternal Wisdom for this divine union to which he is inviting all men, and its consummation in our soul which is being urged forward with such vehemence by the Holy Ghost."

There is a chaplet in honor of the Most Precious Blood that you can easily find from a quick search on the internet. There are two different versions; one meditates on the five wounds on the Cross, and one meditates on the seven times Our Lord shed His Blood.

May the Precious Blood that flows out from the Sacred Heart of Our Lord Jesus Christ cover us now and forever. Amen.




