FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

We had a beautiful celebration last week held at St. Dominic Church. The Loughran Family, from St. Jerome Parish, East Rochester, has been organizing this Seminarian/Vocation Picnic for the past several years now at our parish. Deacon Dermot and Janene have been tremendous supporters of our seminarians over the years, as they befriended me during my summer as a deacon at St. Jerome in 2016.

At the Mass prior to the picnic, we usually have a relatively newly ordained priest to offer the Mass and preach. We try to time it around the feast day of St. John Vianney, patron of parish priests. This year Fr. Joseph Martuscello, ordained for two years, said the Mass and preached while our five seminarians served the Mass. Families from many parishes throughout the diocese, even from the farthest point, in Tioga County, came to meet our seminarians, and pray for vocations to the priesthood.

It has been a wonderful opportunity for families, especially the children, to be able to interact with our priests and seminarians in ways they normally would not be able to. These seminarians are not just faces on a poster, but men who have discerned the call of God deep in their souls. They need our constant prayers. To be in the parish, and to have all these families come together as you see in the picture below, the seminarians (and us priests) are shown clearly why we make such sacrifices and what is at stake.

I especially want to thank all who helped set up (and take down) the tables, chairs, and food. The Knights of Columbus donated enough pulled pork to feed the crowd of over 200 people while families brought various other dishes. We are all grateful for their generosity and for making this event such a success.

PICK OF THE WEEK: *The Bible & The Virgin Mary: Episode 11: The Assumption*




