



FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

As a brief follow-up to last week's article about the Seminarian/Vocations Picnic, I wanted to point out that we had families who came from *nine of the twelve* counties that make up the Diocese of Rochester. That is quite a representation! Cayuga, Tompkins, and Schuyler Counties were the only ones not represented. We'll go for all twelve next year.

This week I wanted to show other great things we had going on at our parish. We had our first Vacation Bible School last week, organized and led by our Faith Formation Coordinator, Sarah Herendeen, and several volunteers who made this week such a success for our children as they learn their Faith in a hands-on and active way. We had at least thirty children registered!

The theme of the week-long camp was "Wilderness Adventures through the Sacraments." Each day the children learned about one of the seven Sacraments, a virtue, a saint or two and a Bible verse. Each day they began by seeing what item was in the "Wilderness Guides Backpack" to help them learn and remember the sacrament for that day. Using music to help the children learn the Bible verse for the day, the children were also relating that lesson to the particular saint or virtue meant for that day. Each day the children would rotate to five different stations: Faith, Snack (very important), Music, Crafts and Games. The days were concluded by gathering together again to review what was learned during the day.



One example of how a day looked is Tuesday when they learned about the Eucharist. I was able to stop in at the very end and see what they were doing. Several children colored pictures for me which are now on my refrigerator. They learned the verse from John 6:51: "I am the living bread that came down from Heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever...." The items in their backpack that day consisted of bread and grapes as they learned about the virtue of gratitude ("Eucharist" means "thanksgiving") and St. Martin de Porres. Many of the children concluded the week by attending the noon Mass on Friday.

This all-too-brief description of the week is simply meant to give you a glimpse of a great program we have at our parish that most people do not see. I am very grateful for Sarah's hard work and dedication in making this possible, and to all those who helped her, both with donating items to be used for the week and helping make this week such a success. I know all the children very much enjoyed their week and now we look forward to the beginning of the Faith Formation year!

PICK OF THE WEEK: Lectio: Mary with Dr. Brant Pitre
The Bible and The Mother of God

Why is Mary so important to Catholics, & why have so many people been devoted to her over the centuries? In this 8-part series, Dr. Brant Pitre examines what the Old & New Testaments, the life of Christ & the early Church Fathers reveal about the life & identity of Mary.

In episode 4, *The Queen Mother*, Dr. Pitre discusses that in the Old Testament, throughout the line of Davidic kings, the queen was not the wife of the king, but rather the kings' mother. As a result, King Solomon placed a throne at his right hand for his queen mother & bowed down in homage to her. Jesus, as the fulfillment of the Davidic line, rules as king of heaven & earth with his mother Mary, as the queen mother.


