





FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Since August 6 falls on a Sunday this year, the Solemnity of the Transfiguration of the Lord supersedes the 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time. It is good to be able to all celebrate this feast day together since it normally falls during the week.

The Transfiguration of the Lord is a profoundly significant event in the life of our Lord (and the Apostles who witnessed it) and we will take a closer look at it. The first thing to notice is that Jesus takes only Peter, James, and John with Him. While all twelve Apostles were given Christ's revelation, there is an inner group of these three that were given special access to the life of Christ. These are the same three that were chosen, after the Last Supper, to be with Him in the Garden of Gethsemane, just before His arrest. One thing that shows us is that there is an important connection between this event and the Passion of our Lord.

Next, Jesus takes them up a "high mountain." In Scripture, the mountain is where someone goes to meet God. We can think of Moses on Mount Sinai, receiving the Law, or Elijah hearing the voice of God there as well. As it turns out, these are precisely the two figures that appear with Jesus at this moment! Moses represents the Law, of which Christ is the fulfillment in His teaching. Elijah represents the prophets, as he is the great miracle worker. Christ fulfills the teaching and work of both as the Incarnate Lord.



Also, Elijah was assumed into heaven, taken away by the fiery chariot in the presence of Elisha. There is also a tradition, though not found directly in Scripture, that Moses was assumed into heaven as well. (We may catch a glimpse of this tradition in Jude 1:9.)

In the Old Testament, the Israelites had a Tent of Meeting. When the cloud of God's presence came over it, they knew God was there. This cloud is called the *shekinah*. Just when Peter speaks up and offers to make a tent for them to dwell in, the *shekinah* comes to show them where God truly dwells: in Christ. This is why the same voice heard at the Baptism of the Lord returns again: "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him."

As God gave his Word through Moses in the form of the Law, and through Elijah as prophecy, as instruction for the people, now we have here the Word-made-Flesh, showing His glory to His Apostles. It is made clear that the Word Himself is among them. Moses and Elijah both pointed to Christ in their lives and teaching. Now we are told to, "Listen to *Him.*" We do not have to go on a high mountain to find our Lord. He is with us in His Word in Sacred Scripture, and substantially present to us in the Most Holy Eucharist. Take the time to be present to Him who is always present to us whenever we seek Him.






