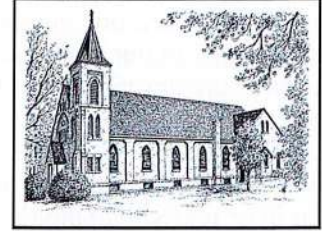

## FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Maintaining the interior peace that we so desire is not ultimately about never having struggles or temptations to conquer. The truth is that we will always have temptations of this or that sort. This is simply part of our earthly life. The key is to learn how to maintain our peace even in the midst of great struggle, and especially if we happen to fall into sin.

There may be various reasons why we do not have the quiet in our soul that we desire. There may be fear, discouragement, anger, or something else. Perhaps we are seeking the kind of peace merely that *this world* pretends to give us. But Christ tells us differently: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid" (John 14:27). These consoling words come from the mouth of God Himself and remind us that what we truly desire is not something that this world can give. The peace we desire comes from Him alone.

All we need to begin to have this peace is simply goodwill. Having goodwill or purity of heart is not necessarily a perfection in this case. We can see our goodwill as a stable disposition to love God, do His will, and to love our neighbor. Such goodwill can coexist in our soul with imperfections and faults that we may have. But without this goodwill, we will never advance towards greater virtue and love of God. Our goodwill is the opening to allow God to work in us more and more, by His grace.

I may have mentioned before that this book, *Searching for and Maintaining Peace*, is probably the only book that I have ever written in or underlined anything. I like to keep my books pristine (that may not be surprising to you). However, the following passage is one that I highlighted and starred because of the clarity of a truth that was previously lacking articulation. It is worth quoting in full:

"This goodwill, this habitual determination to always say 'yes' to God, in the great things as in the small, is a *sine qua non* for interior peace. As long as we have not acquired this determination, a certain uneasiness and sadness will not cease to abide in us – the uneasiness of not loving God as much as He invites us to love Him, and the sadness of still not having given all things to God. Because the man who has given his will to God has, in a certain fashion, already given Him everything.

We cannot truly be at peace as long as our hearts have not found their unity and our hearts cannot be unified until all our desires are subordinated to the desire to love God, to please Him and to do His will. This also implies, of course, an habitual determination to detach ourselves from all that is contrary to God. Here, then, is what goodwill consists of, the necessary condition for peace of the soul."

A blessed first week of Lent to you all!

### THE SEASON OF LENT HAS BEGUN

Traditionally, the Lenten season is a time of penance, prayer, the reception of the sacraments, charity and almsgiving. The following are various Lenten regulations:

**Good Friday**—along with Ash Wednesday, this is a day of fast & abstinence from meat. Everyone between the ages of 18 & 59 inclusive are limited to one full meal on this day.

**All Fridays of Lent**—Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. All those 14 & up are bound to abstain from meat.

**Other Weekdays of Lent**—There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended (like giving up something difficult.)
