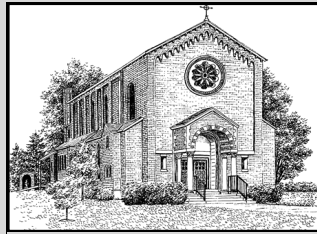
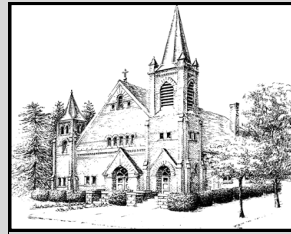


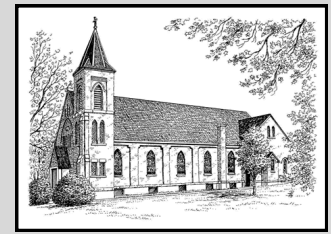

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Finally, we are halfway through Advent and it is *Gaudete* Sunday! As St. Paul tells us in this weekend's second reading: "Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice! Your kindness should be known to all. The Lord is near." The great joy of Christmas will be upon us soon. And we come to the conclusion of our tour through the Roman Canon:

"Through whom you continue to make all these good things, O Lord; you make them holy, fill them with life, bless them, and bestow them upon us.

Through him, and with him, and in him, to you, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honor and glory is yours, for ever and ever. Amen."

The conclusion of the Canon is also called the "minor" or "little" elevation. This contrasts with the elevation immediately after the Consecration where the people are invited to adore the Lord under the veil of the Most Holy Sacrament held high. At this point in particular we should notice that all the people are invited to respond, "Amen."

The entire Eucharistic Prayer prior to this point is the priest's prayer, on behalf of the people, to which the people unite themselves. At this point, we have offered Jesus back to the Father in adoration and we have prayed for all of our needs. The people respond, "Amen," and so show their assent to all that has been said and voice their desire to be with Him.

It is made clear again at the conclusion that prayers are address *to* the Father, *through* the Son, and *in* the Holy Spirit. Yet, in speaking to the Father the priest says/chants, "Through Him, and with Him, and in Him...". It is *through* Christ as our Mediator that gap between God and man is bridged. It is through Christ that we pray giving honor and glory to God, just as Jesus Himself did in every action of His earthly life (and does so eternally). We are *with Him* as the Mystical Body of Christ offering our lives to the glory of God. We maintain this union *in Him* by His grace, God's own life living within us.

By this *Doxology*, this praise to Almighty God, we can almost imagine Christ Himself saying these words to the Father at the consummation of the world. When at last, all those are saved whom God had foreknown from eternity, Christ's work of redemption is accomplished, and so the breach between God and man is closed. All the angels of heaven, with those who are saved, will fall down before the throne of God and sing in adoration forever. Let us live in anticipation of this heavenly hope at every Mass.
