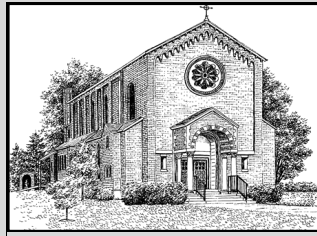


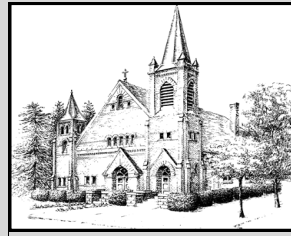

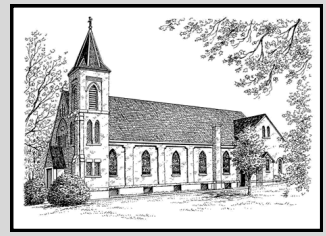

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Merry Christmas! We were privileged this year to have nearly four full weeks of Advent in which to prepare for the coming of Christ into the world. I hope this time was fruitful for your spiritual life, and the peace of your soul.

We now celebrate one of the most astonishing facts in human history: God is with us. It sounds so simple, yet to think that the infinite and eternal God who made the universe, the stars, planets, and everything we can see (and cannot see), chose to become one of us so as to *be with us*, not merely in Spirit alone, but in Body, is to know an incomprehensible Love.

As the Gospel for the Vigil Mass for Christmas tells us in the Gospel of Matthew, St. Joseph had a dream telling him to take Mary into his home because "the virgin shall be with child and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel," which means 'God is with us'" (Mt 1:23). Referring to the words of Isaiah, Joseph was told that this child is God in the midst of His people. His very name indicates that He will save His people from their sins.

At the Mass During the Night, we are invited to enter that cold, dark field with the shepherds who must have been awaiting the redemption of Israel. We can imagine the fear when "the angel of the Lord appeared to them and the glory of the Lord shone around them" (Luke 2:9), but the first words from the angel are the same ones he spoke to Mary – words we all need to hear in such times: "*Do not be afraid*; for behold, I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people" (Luke 2:10). As these shepherds were close to Jerusalem, tending their flocks all year, it is likely that these flocks were destined for the Temple Sacrifice in Jerusalem. It is thus quite fitting that the heavenly host would appear to those tending the flocks of animals whose sacrifice foreshadows the one, true, and final sacrifice of the Lamb of God, who was born that very night in the City of David. At such Good News, how can we help but sing with the hosts of angels: "Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace to men of good will" (Luke 2:14)?

As the morning comes on Christmas, at this darkest time of the year, we are reminded by the Prologue of the Gospel of John that, "What came to be through [the Word] was life, and this life was the light of the human race; *the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it*" (John 1:4-5). What a joy and a privilege it is each year to celebrate the Eternal Word of God who chose to become *flesh and dwell among us!* (John 1:14). He became like us so that we can become like Him.

As we celebrate the birth of Christ, and as we come to the end of the civil year, we take the time to remember all the things for which we are grateful. I am profoundly grateful for all of you and I am honored to be your priest. These past six months have been, for me, joyful, peaceful, and – I pray – holy. May the newborn King, our Lord Jesus Christ, reign in your hearts this Christmas Season, and always, as we continually contemplate the great mystery of the Incarnation of the Son of God. May He fill you with His Light, grace, warmth, and peace.

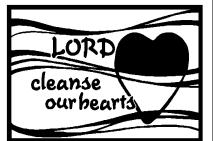
