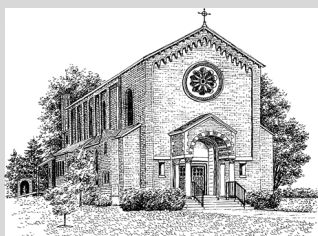
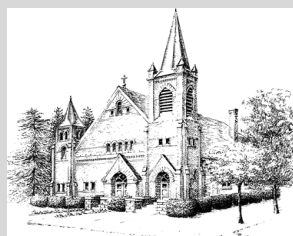


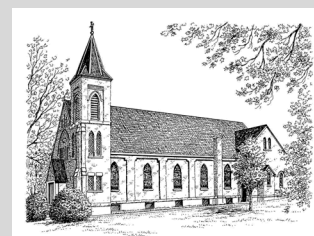

**FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER VAN LIESHOUT**

Praised be Jesus Christ!  
On Tuesday of this past week, the Church celebrated the "Feast of the Presentation of Christ in the Temple" also known as the "Feast of the Purification of Mary" and even "Candlemas" on account of the blessing of candles which takes place on that day.

Last year "Candlemas" fell on a Sunday, and so I was able to do a very public blessing of candles—both those to be used in the parish and those brought in by parishioners. Even though we had no parish Mass this past Tuesday, I just want to say that I am always happy to bless any candles brought in by parishioners for private use in your homes. This could be for candles used at the dinner table, Advent wreath candles for next year, devotional candles for home altars/prayer spaces, etc. Just catch me in the sacristy before or after Mass. The blessing only takes a minute, but the prayer of blessing is very powerful. The English translation reads:

*Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the living God, bless these candles at our lowly request. Endow them, Lord, by the power of the holy cross, with a blessing from on high, you who gave them to mankind in order to dispel darkness. Let the blessing that they receive from the sign of the holy cross be so effectual that, wherever they are lighted or placed, the princes of darkness may depart in trembling from all these places, and flee in fear, along with all their legions, and never more dare to disturb or molest those who serve you, the almighty God, who live and reign forever and ever.*

And while on the topic of blessings and sacramentals—I realize that we are still unable to fill the Holy Water fonts at the entrances of the church, but you are welcome and encouraged to bring in containers and fill them up with Holy Water from the large repositories in the back of each of our churches. The containers don't have to be an official Holy Water bottle. You can use any clean container, and just label it accordingly as "Holy Water."
