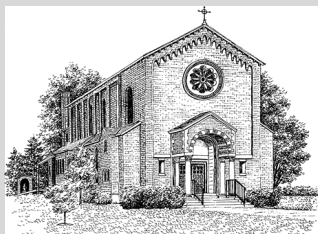


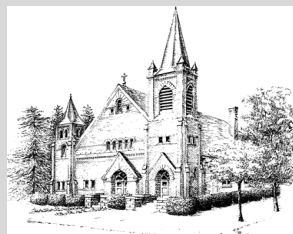

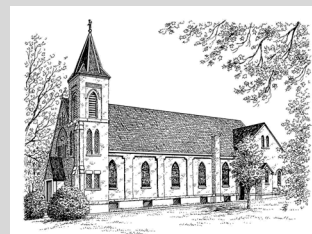

**FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER VAN LIESHOUT**

Praised be Jesus Christ!

The feast of St. Joseph on March 19<sup>th</sup> is always one of those important moments of celebration in the midst of what is otherwise the Church's chief penitential season of Lent. But this year St. Joseph's Day takes on greater significance given the fact that this is a special devotional "Year of St. Joseph" in the universal Church. It will also be an important moment for our parish as a sizeable group of men will make a public act of consecration to St. Joseph, having completed 33 days of prayer and study using Fr. Don Calloway's book *Consecration to St. Joseph*.

I want to make sure that we celebrate this day properly so I am proposing a full schedule of devotions and sacramental opportunities that will stretch throughout the greater portion of the entire day. To help us do so, I have invited Fr. Matthew Walters to join us for some of the evening events. You might remember Fr. Walters if you attended the Miraculous Medal Blessing and Investiture back in the fall. He is a priest of our Diocese with a very genuine and longstanding devotion to St. Joseph. I can't tell you the number of times throughout the years that Fr. Walters has brought up St. Joseph in the midst of conversations—always entrusting his intentions and needs to this great saint in a truly filial way. I'm so grateful that he can come to share his love for St. Joseph with us.

I encourage you to take advantage of these opportunities to the extent that you are able! **All of these events/devotions will take place at St. Dominic's Church.**

Feast of St. Joseph Schedule – Friday, March 19<sup>th</sup>

10am - 10:45am – **Confessions (heard by Fr. Van Lieshout)**

11am – **Stations of the Cross**

Noon – **Mass of the Solemnity of St. Joseph (by Fr. Van Lieshout in English)**

12:45pm – 5pm – **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament**

5:15pm – 6pm – **Confessions (heard by Fr. Matthew Walters)**

6:15pm – **Sung Latin Mass of the Feast of St. Joseph (celebrated by Fr. Matthew Walters)**

7:15pm – **Sermon by Fr. Walters on devotion to St. Joseph\***

7:45pm – **Public Act of Consecration to St. Joseph by the men of the parish**

\*Note that Fr. Walter's sermon will take place AFTER the Latin Mass so as to allow others to come and hear him speak who may not have attended the Mass immediately preceding.

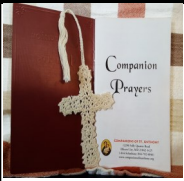
