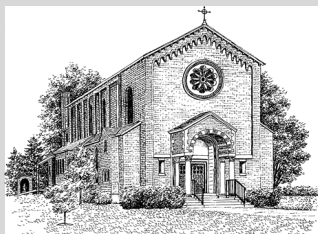
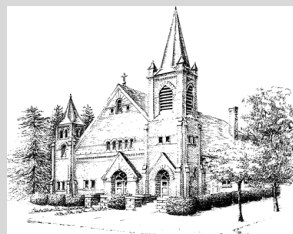


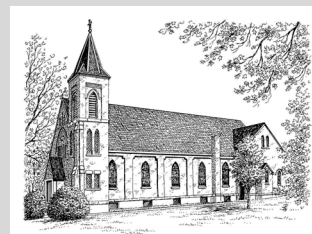

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER VAN LIESHOUT

Praised be Jesus Christ!

As we begin the holiest week of our liturgical year, I offer my standard notes of encouragement on how to best live out these last days of Lent.

First of all, whatever you do, make sure that this week "feels" different than any other. Add some extra penance, stop by the church for quiet prayer, do some extra Scriptural/spiritual reading, etc. The joy of Easter becomes all the more authentic the better that we prepare by the discipline of Lent and a serious engagement with Holy Week and the Sacred Triduum.

Of course I certainly encourage you to join us in person for the liturgies of the Sacred Triduum—Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil of Holy Saturday. These liturgies will not be livestreamed as they will take place at St. Francis Church (on Thursday and Friday) and St. Dominic Church (on Saturday), neither of which have internet access available. Besides it is my hope that we are *nearing* the end of our need for such livestreamed "options." Be assured that I will continue to record all Sunday Masses and Holy Days of Obligation for as long as the dispensation from Mass remains in place, but I also want to take every opportunity to try to wean us off what was always meant to be a temporary solution to an unexpected crisis, and never an indefinite replacement for the Church's public worship, which is by its very nature "communal" and "in-person."

Finally, I'm happy to announce the Holy Week confession schedule, with times arranged for your convenience. Please note that this schedule replaces (for this week) the normal weekly confession schedule:

- Monday, March 29th – 4:30pm to 7pm at St. Dominic Church (visiting priest)
- Wednesday, March 31st – 4:30pm to 6pm at St. Felix Church (Fr. Van Lieshout)
- Good Friday – 5pm to 6:30pm at St. Francis Church (Fr. Van Lieshout)
- Holy Saturday – 3pm to 4pm at St. Dominic Church (Fr. Van Lieshout)
