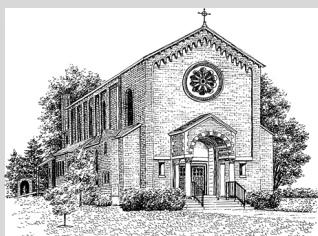


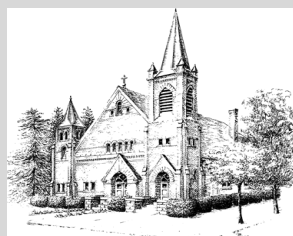

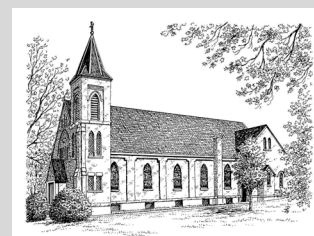

Solemnity of the Annunciation

Dear *Peter*,

I hope that you are well and that many spiritual graces are being poured out upon you and your people during this Lenten season...

Very recently on our streets we experienced the horrific death of Steven Amenhauser. Absolutely no one deserves to die the way he did, sprayed with flammable liquid and then lit with a match. It goes beyond our sensibilities to comprehend how such a non-existent sense of human life could exist. It shakes us to the core to think that this is the kind of society that we are passing onto our young...

As we come to this Solemnity of the Annunciation, I am acutely aware of how Mary's response was always a "Yes" to the Lord, whereas on numerous occasions our response both personally and communally to Our Lord, is "No". Sadly, as a society, this often takes the form of diminishing, assaulting, and even attacking and tragically ending God's beautiful gift of life. As members of the Church, we know that this is happening on many fronts... For sure it is happening at the very beginning of human life, when the most innocent and defenseless of our brothers and sisters, who are without a voice are done away with at will, with no protection whatever. In some States, including our own, this is true through the nine months of pregnancy and right up to the moment of birth. And unbelievably, if a child were born that had been slated for abortion, no aide to that child is legally mandated. In fact, the opposite may be true – the mandate may be not to give aide.

On top of this, the federal government already is trying to force people and institutions within and outside of the Church to go against our conscience to have to perform abortions, by eliminating the Mexico City Policy, as well as force the tax payers in all States to pay for them... The Hyde Amendment, which was established so that Medicaid would not pay for abortion (except where the mother's life was at risk and was expanded in cases of rape and incest), is being threatened to be ended for the first time in 43 years... In addition, Planned Parenthood, the largest pro-abortion provider in the world, continues to promote abortion at will. Locally, a number of our faithful, lovingly sacrifice their time and comfort by being on the front lines to pray and offer alternatives at this place where a large number of abortions regularly occur. Soon, they will be receiving a mobile van with an ultrasound unit to help them to be more effective in witnessing to the life growing within those going into Planned Parenthood... For sure, these loving advocates for life, could use prayerful intercession, as well as for all those serving in crisis pregnancy centers.

For this week's column, I would like to share with you a letter that I recently received from another one of the priests in our Diocese, Fr. Tony Mugavero. Fr. Mugavero works in the very heart of the streets of Rochester, and if anyone knows him, he is one of the kindest and soft-spoken priests that you'll ever meet. So the very fact that he sent this letter to other priests (which isn't common), and the topic and tone of the letter, make it stand out.

Besides these assaults on the beginning of human life, we have so many attacks on the ending of human life from euthanasia to assisted suicide, as well as, so much diminishing human life in between its beginning and ending. Just to mention a few of these evils: the scourge of racism to sex-trafficking; the plight of immigrants and refugees to the violence on our streets; the debilitating consequences of poverty to the way that we are not fully caring for the earth. And so more could be added to this list!

From the beginning to the end and including everything in between, human life is being respected less and less... No wonder, Pope Saint John Paul II called it "the culture of death" .... All these life issues are tugging at our hearts to begin interceding for them in a new way... For sure, these assaults on our brothers and sisters, demand our attention and our prayer. St. James reminds us that "The fervent prayer of a righteous person is very powerful." The disciples asked Jesus, "Why could we not drive the demon out?" He said to them, "This kind can only come out through prayer."

Will you help? Will you be willing to establish a time of prayer, of exposition, of adoration in your parish once a week for all the issues of life? Would you be willing to establish within your parish a morning, an evening, or an entire day, once a week, where these intentions could be more faithfully and intensely prayed for? I am asking you to consider a time of exposition of the Blessed Sacrament each week in your parish... A day, a morning, or an afternoon, where Holy Hours for Life are being offered to the Lord, on behalf of all the affronts to the most beautiful gift of human life.

I will be calling you regarding this during the Easter season... My hope, my prayer is that your answer will be like Mary's ... "Yes!"

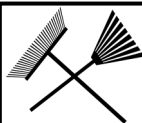

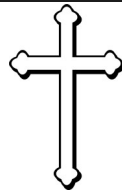
