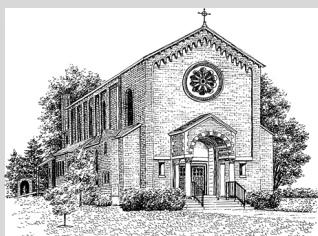


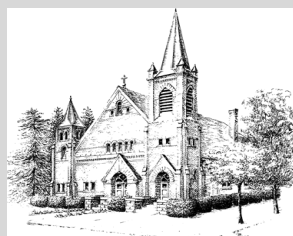

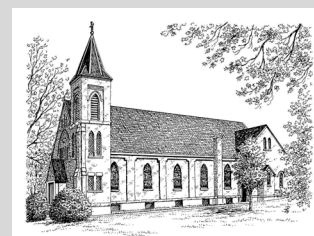

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER VAN LIESHOUT

Last week at the end of Sunday Masses, I made the difficult announcement that Bishop Matano has *appointed me to a new assignment as Rector of Sacred Heart Cathedral, thus ending my time as Pastor of St. Peter's Parish*. This change in assignment will take effect on June 29th.

I would like to recap here in writing some of the points that I made verbally last week from the pulpit.

The first thing that I stressed is that this was not a change that I sought of my own accord. In fact, I had resolved never to ask for a change in assignment unless I thought that I could no longer be effective as Pastor of St. Peter's Parish—and I didn't think that I had reached that point yet! But I had also resolved as part of my priestly duties that I would willingly serve this Diocese in whatever capacity my Bishop might ask, and that I wouldn't stand in the way of whatever else the Lord might will for the spiritual good of this parish.

With that in mind, *I am happy to announce that the new Pastor of St. Peter's Parish will be Fr. Anthony Amato*. Fr. Amato is another young priest, a few months younger than I am, and was ordained almost four years ago. He currently serves as the Parochial Vicar of St. Maximilian Kolbe and St. Katherine Drexel parishes in northwest Wayne county. Full disclosure--he is also a good friend of mine, and I know him to be an excellent priest. I think what this means is that in some important respects, there will be a continuity of vision to help build upon some of the great things that are happening in this parish, while I'm also sure that Fr. Amato will come with his own gifts and pastoral priorities. I am consoled to know that you will be in good hands!

As difficult as change is, I hope that all of our parishioners can seize this as an excellent opportunity to generate some good "buzz" and excitement about the new Pastor. I know well that news travels fast through our small towns, and I hope that we can frame this in a very positive light, letting people know that there will be an excellent new priest in town, and that the faith is alive and well in St. Peter's Parish. I also pray that to whatever extent I may have played some role in your particular walk with the Lord and his Church, you will continue to remain committed and look to Fr. Amato for continued growth and guidance.

I still have over two months before my new assignment takes effect, and I'll certainly have plenty more to say before I leave, but I at least want to make sure that you know how much I appreciate how good you have all been to me, and how much this parish means to me! There are many incredible things taking place in our churches and in our parishioners, and I will look on with a sort of holy "jealousy" to see Fr. Amato benefit from this same kindness and watch the parish continue to grow and build under the direction of his pastorate.

I'm not saying any goodbyes yet, but I AM asking for your prayers for me and Fr. Amato and our entire parish as we begin to plan for this transition.

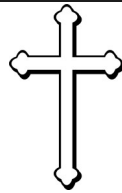
