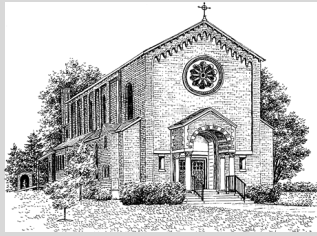
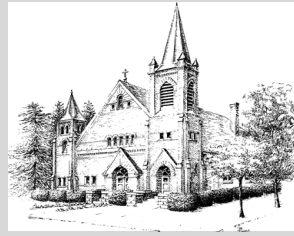


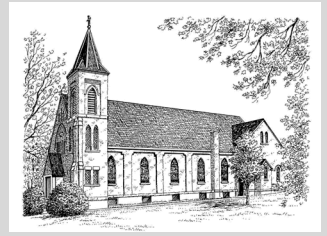

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER VAN LIESHOUT

Praised be Jesus Christ!

"Christ is Risen! Indeed, He is Risen!"

This classic trope of Easter joy is often used as an expression of friendly greeting between Christians during the Easter season. One person will say: "Christ is Risen!" and the expected response is repeated back by the other: "Indeed, He is Risen!" After a long Lent, and a beautiful but exhausting (for me, anyway) Triduum, these simple words touch my soul in a way that is hard to describe—I hear it, and I can't help but smile and feel consoled and united in a deep communion of faith with other Christian believers throughout the world.

But it also strikes me as a *bold expression of confidence in the face of a world which seems ever more enveloped in an oppressive secularism, a debased moral order, and the darkness of a purposeless vision of human existence.*

To say that "Christ is Risen" is to say to **that** world: "I reject your empty and sad vision of reality and proclaim a God who is living and active and powerful in the lives of those who believe."

To say that "Christ is Risen" is to say to **that** world: "I reject your lies which cultivate and celebrate moral depravity and disordered sinful desires and I proclaim instead that we are called to put to death sinful passions and seek a life that is 'above,' transcendent in virtue, and alive in Christ."

To say that "Christ is Risen" is to say to **that** world: "I reject vain attempts at self-salvation and earthly utopias, and believe that Christ alone is the Way, the Truth, and the Life which never ends, alone capable of fulfilling the desires of the human heart and providing the antidote for life everlasting."

As you sit down with family and friends to your Easter meals—some for the first time in many months—be sure to speak to the darkness of this fallen world this message of hope:

"Christ is Risen! Indeed, He is Risen!"
