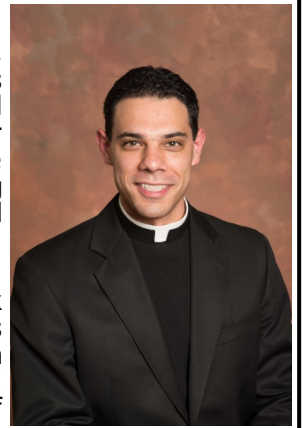
MEET OUR SOON-TO-BE, NEW PASTOR, FR. ANTHONY AMATO

I was born in Greece, NY and I am the second of four boys in my family. We were educated at our parish, Our Mother of Sorrows, and then attended the Aquinas Institute of Rochester for high school. It was there, during my senior year, that I first considered the call to the priesthood. I did not pursue that call at first, but I began a Computer Science major at the University of Rochester in the Fall of 2005. Rather quickly during that first year of college, I realized that I needed to explore my desire to think and write on topics in philosophy and religious studies. I switched to a double-major in those areas and during those years, I continued to develop a prayer-life. As I had entered my third year of college, I had decided that I wanted to pursue graduate studies in theology and become a college professor. As I graduated in May 2009, I began graduate studies at Boston College School of Theology and Ministry that Fall.

It was there, in Boston, living on my own for the first time, that I kept hearing a persistent call to look deeper into the possibility of being a priest. I committed myself to praying the Liturgy of the Hours throughout the day and by the end of my first year of my Master's program, I began the conversation with the Diocese of Rochester to begin seminary when I graduate. Through a life of study and prayer, I was able to discern who God was calling me to be. I graduated in May 2011 and began the first year of seminary, in Rochester, that summer.

In August of 2012, the diocese sent me to study at Theological College at the Catholic University of America in Washington, DC. After four years of study, and a pastoral year at St. Mary's in Auburn, NY, I earned a Licentiate in Sacred Theology and was ordained a priest on June 3, 2017. The bishop sent me to Tioga County, at St. Patrick Parish and Blessed Trinity Parish, as the parochial vicar, for my first assignment. I was then assigned to the parishes of St. Maximilian Kolbe and St. Katharine Drexel, in western Wayne County.

I have learned a lot in these four years of my priesthood, and I will certainly miss the many people with whom I have grown close. This is part of the life of a priest: to go where I am sent, to preach the Gospel, and to love those I am called to serve. I am *greatly looking forward* to coming to St. Peter's Parish, as your priest. Please pray for me as I begin my ministry here, so that I may more perfectly imitate Christ the Good Shepherd.



PRAY FOR VOCATIONS WITH MOTHERS OF LU!

The Mothers of Lu is the remarkable vocations story of mothers from the small Italian village of Lu, who, in 1881, met weekly to pray not only for vocations to the priesthood and religious life, but prayed in a particular way for these vocations to come from their own families. The story witnesses, "Through the trusting prayer of these mothers and openness of the other parents, an atmosphere of deep joy and Christian piety developed in the families, making it much easier for the children to recognize their vocations." 323 vocations was the astonishing fruit of the Lu mothers' prayers: 152 priests & 171 nuns! A 21st Century Mothers of Lu Prayer group was formed in the Diocese of Rochester to pray with the same specific intention of calling priests and religious from our own families. The group pledges to: meet on the *first Tuesday of the month* at 7 pm at Sacred Heart Cathedral to pray for this intention; pray weekly the Lu Vocations Prayer; and receive the Holy Eucharist on the first Sunday of the month for this intention. "O God, grant that one of my sons may become a priest! I, myself, want to live as a good Christian and want to guide my children always to do what is right, so that I may receive the grace, O God, to be allowed to give You a holy priest! Amen."

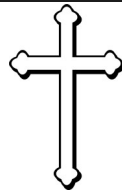
