FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER VAN LIESHOUT

Praised be Jesus Christ!

The month of June begins with the feast of St. Justin Martyr on June 1st, a early defender of the Christian faith who died at Rome somewhere around 165AD for his refusal to offer sacrifice to the pagan gods.

Almost every year on his feast day, I go back and flip through some of his writings, particularly his work known as the *First Apologia*—which is written as a sort of open letter to the Emperor explaining and defending Christian beliefs in the face of common misconceptions and calumnies which were prominent at his time in the Empire.

His clear statement on the doctrine of the Eucharist, written just one generation after the death of the last apostle, always brings me such confidence and consolation, knowing that our Eucharistic faith is the very same faith as the very earliest generations of Christians and that there is in St. Justin Martyr—as well as others—clear historical testimony of unimpeachable authenticity to this fact. He writes:

And this food is called among us Eὐχαριστία [the Eucharist], of which no one is allowed to partake but the man who believes that the things which we teach are true, and who has been washed with the washing that is for the remission of sins, and unto regeneration, and who is so living as Christ has enjoined. For not as common bread and common drink do we receive these; but in like manner as Jesus Christ our Savior, having been made flesh by the Word of God, had both flesh and blood for our salvation, so likewise have we been taught that the food which is blessed by the prayer of His word, and from which our blood and flesh by transmutation are nourished, is the flesh and blood of that Jesus who was made flesh. For the apostles, in the memoirs composed by them, which are called Gospels, have thus delivered unto us what was enjoined upon them; that Jesus took bread, and when He had given thanks, said, "This do in remembrance of Me, this is My body;" and that, after the same manner, having taken the cup and given thanks, He said, "This is My blood;" and gave it to them alone.
