FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

This week, on July 22, we celebrate the Feast of St. Mary Magdalene. It was only five years ago now that Pope Francis elevated this day to the rank of 'Feast.' It was formally a 'Memorial.' I know that normally when we speak about various feast days, we do not make distinctions between a 'Memorial,' a 'Feast,' and a 'Solemnity.' However, there is an important difference that signals to us how each of these special days on the calendar relates to the central mysteries of our Faith.

Prior to the current Roman Calendar we use, everything was a 'Feast,' but either a 'first class,' 'second class,' or 'third class.' Prior to that, it was even more complicated. So, why did the Pope elevate the Memorial of St. Mary Magdalene to a Feast? It is precisely because he wished to emphasize for us the role she played in the mystery of our salvation, as shown to us in the Gospels.

Looking at the Gospels from the perspective of God's desire to give his Mercy to all people through His Son Jesus Christ, we see how crucial it is to understand what God has done for Mary Magdalene and how she was a chosen instrument to be the first to bring the message of the Resurrection to the world. This is why she is called the 'apostolorum apostola,' the 'Apostle of the Apostles.' John 20:16-18 is clear that Mary Magdalene saw the Risen Lord, she recognized Him when He spoke her name, and she went to the other disciples to proclaim, "I have seen the Lord." The work of an apostle is to proclaim precisely this, that I have seen the Risen Lord, and that He calls me by name (for the first time in baptism).

St. Anselm of Canterbury, in praise to St. Mary Magdalene, calls her "chosen because you are beloved and beloved because you are chosen of God." She was chosen to show the world how to weep at the loss of her Savior and God, first in her own soul, then when she saw the empty tomb, because she could not see the One who showed her mercy. Yet, in an instant, her tears of sorrow were turned to tears of joy when she heard her name and knew it was Him, the One who loved her because He had forgiven her.

This is why she now has a 'Feast' equivalent to the Apostles in liturgical solemnity. She proclaimed the message of the Risen Christ and so was the first witness to the Divine Mercy.
