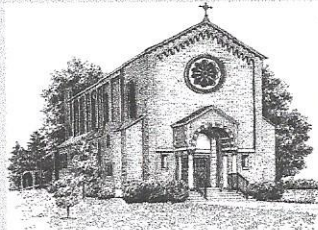

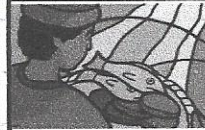

## FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

You may have heard that last week, July 16, *Memorial of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel*, the Holy Father, Pope Francis, released a decree entitled *Traditionis Custodes*. This decree put strict limitations on the use of the Traditional Latin Mass (also known as the "Extraordinary Form" or simply the "Latin Mass") which was the Mass as it existed prior to the Second Vatican Council, the 1962 Roman Missal. There are several priests in our diocese, including me, your previous pastor, and my closest friends, who celebrate the Mass according to the 1962 Missal. I know for a fact that I would not be the priest that I am, or maybe not even simply the man that I am, without the influence of that Mass and the ability to celebrate it.

My love of that Mass has a clear influence on my love and devotion during the celebration of the current Roman Rite, promulgated by St. Paul VI and St. John Paul II. I know so many of you appreciate the beauty and reverence brought to the Mass by my predecessor, and so you, too, have been formed whether directly or indirectly by the Traditional Latin Mass. It is a tremendous gift to benefit from, and live out of, our full, rich Catholic Tradition, in its teachings and its liturgy.

This is why *Traditiones Custodes* has caused me, and so many others, much sadness, grief, and disappointment. For now, I am very grateful to Bishop Matano for allowing the Mass according to the 1962 Roman Missal to continue as it was, until the details of the Pope's decree can be understood and implemented accordingly. You can read the document, and it's accompanying letter to the bishops of the world, for yourself, but it raises a lot of questions and has caused much dismay throughout the world. I am grateful that the Extraordinary Form of the Mass will continue for now, and I am certainly hopeful that it will continue in the future and even see a growth in its attendance.

The main concern of the Holy Father, however, is one that we can all appreciate. That concern is for the *unity of the Church*. We must pray for this. Even in the Roman Canon, there is a prayer for unity at the very beginning, and there is another prayer addressed to Christ during the Communion Rite. If you look around on the internet for commentary, you may see much vitriol regarding this decree. Division is from the devil. Unity and peace are from God. We can never give in to such anger and resentment. We may not understand what is happening, but we believe in a God who is all merciful and whose loving Providence governs all things. This is where we rest our hope. It is only in this that we will have true peace. Please continue to pray for our Holy Father Francis, for Bishop Matano, and all the bishops of the Church for whatever will bring unity to the Mystical Body of Christ and honor and glory to our Eternal Father.

### PRAY FOR VOCATIONS WITH MOTHERS OF LU!

The Mothers of Lu is the remarkable vocations story of mothers from the small Italian village of Lu, who, in 1881, met weekly to pray not only for vocations to the priesthood and religious life, but prayed in a particular way for these vocations to come from their own families. The story witnesses, *"Through the trusting prayer of these mothers and openness of the other parents, an atmosphere of deep joy and Christian piety developed in the families, making it much easier for the children to recognize their vocations."*

**323 vocations** was the astonishing fruit of the Lu mothers' prayers: **152 priests** and **171 nuns!**

A 21st Century Mothers of Lu Prayer group was formed in the Diocese of Rochester to pray with the same specific intention of calling priests and religious from our own families. The group pledges to:

- meet at 7pm on the first Tuesday of the month at Sacred Heart Cathedral to pray for this intention in Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament (next meeting—**Aug. 3<sup>rd</sup>**);
- pray weekly the Lu Vocations Prayer with either Rosary/Adoration;
- and receive the Holy Eucharist on the first Sunday of the month for this intention.

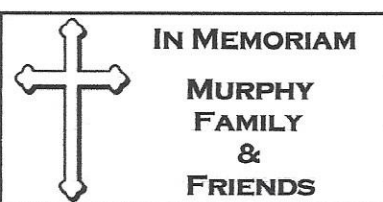

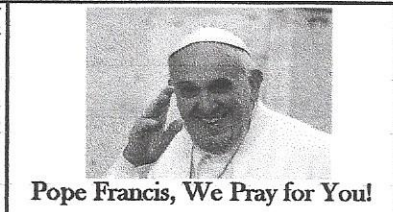
