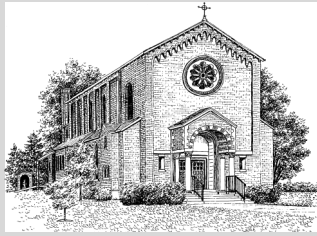
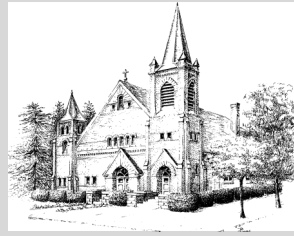


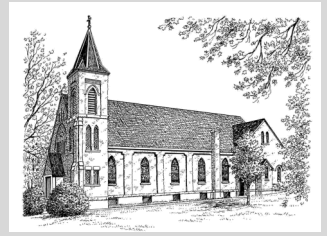

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

First, I want to thank all of you for your warm welcome, your kindness, and generosity in this first week. It is not easy to move from one parish to another once you get to know and love the people there, but you have made the transition as smooth as it can be.

As you know, this past week we celebrated the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul. In the older calendar, prior to 1970, this feast day had a liturgy for the *vigil* of the great feast as well, as we still do for other great feasts (such as the Assumption of Mary, coming up soon). So, there I was on June 28, my last full day in my previous assignment and looking forward to my new assignment. I was praying Matins from the Divine Office, and the readings for the day are from a homily by St. Augustine, preaching on John 21:15-19. It is where Our Lord asks Peter three times, "Do you love me?" Augustine has this to say:

"This thrice-uttered injunction of Christ puts us on guard, therefore, against those whom the Apostle deplores as seeking their own interests, not those of Jesus Christ. For when He says, 'If you love Me, feed My sheep,' this is equivalent to saying, 'If you love Me, do not think of feeding yourself, but feed My sheep as Mine and not as your own; seek My glory in them and not your own; My dominance and not yours.... Therefore, we are to love Him, not ourselves, and in feeding His sheep we are to seek His interests, not ours. For in some way which I cannot explain, it is true that anyone who loves himself and not God, does not love himself; and he who loves God and not himself, does love himself."


As I read that I knew I would share that with you in my first bulletin article. Those are words that priests always need to keep in mind. Pray that I live up to those words. While you are our spiritual children, you belong to God, and God has commanded us to feed His lambs and to feed His sheep. This is cause for seeking great humility on our part. And I was so caught up thinking about coming to my new assignment that I completely forgot that June 28 is also the anniversary of my baptism. (Do you know the date of your baptism?) The day I celebrate becoming one of His lambs is the eve of the day I became one His shepherds.
