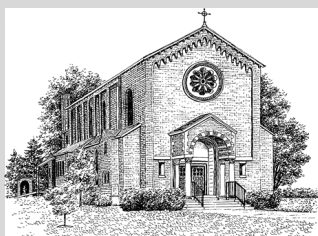


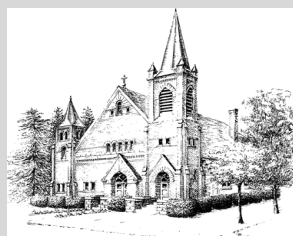

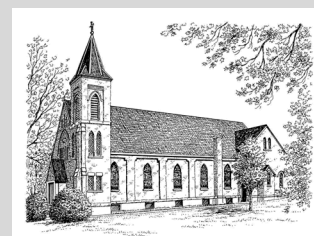

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Last week we celebrated the glorious Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This week we conclude John 6 and the Bread of Life discourse. In the older Roman calendar, prior to 1970, August 22 was celebrated in honor of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. This was the octave day of the Assumption of Mary. Major feast days were given Octaves as a way to extend the Feast day, celebrating its importance in the life of the Church. Now, we have two Octaves: Christmas and Easter. Typically, octaves conclude with another major feast day. The Christmas Octave concludes on January 1 with the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. And now the Easter Octave concludes with Divine Mercy Sunday.

In the bulletin I wrote briefly about the connection between the Immaculate Conception and the Assumption. This connection was made clear in the liturgy through the Feast of the Immaculate Heart and its occurrence on the octave day of the Assumption.

You may know that at Fatima, Our Lady assured us that her Immaculate Heart will be our refuge. We are always in need of taking refuge in her all-pure, immaculate heart, and we should turn to her for any need.

One of my favorite Marian prayers is called the *Memorare*:

**Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary
that never was it known
that anyone who fled to thy protection
implored thy help or sought thy intercession
was left unaided.**

**Inspired by this confidence,
I fly unto thee,
O Virgin of virgins, My Mother.**

**To thee do I come,
before thee I stand,
sinful and sorrowful.**

**O Mother of the Word Incarnate,
despise not my petitions,
but in thy clemency
hear and answer me. Amen.**

The prayer begins with a cry of confidence in Our Mother that she will always hear us, her children. We can run to her and always have assistance from the throne of God! We also recognize how much we are in need of mercy. Fortunately, she is the Mother of Mercy...our life, our sweetness, and our hope.

Traditionally, this prayer was attributed to St. Bernard of Clairvaux (12th century), but it was definitely popularized by Fr. Claude Bernard in the 17th century. He claimed to learn it directly from his father. He attributes his own miraculous healing to the Blessed Virgin Mary, after saying this prayer. This prayer had a profound effect in his ministry to the prisoners, particularly those condemned to death. He was able to evangelize those who were in such a dire situation by showing them that they, too, have a Mother who loves them.

I encourage all to go to Our Mother with the words of the *Memorare*, with any intention you may have. If we go to her with all sincerity, humility, and confidence, her Immaculate Heart will intercede for us, with her Son, the Incarnate Word.
