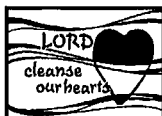


NEXT SUNDAY IS THE 4th SUNDAY OF THE MONTH. COME PRAY THE ROSARY WITH RESPECT LIFE!

KNIGHT OF THE YEAR

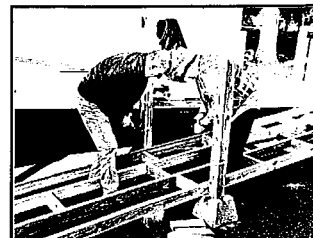
Tom Gordner, an exceptional Catholic man, has been selected as the 2022 Knight of the Year. Congratulations Tom!

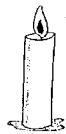

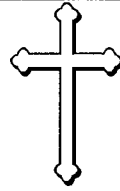

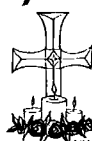
