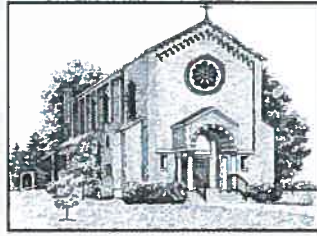


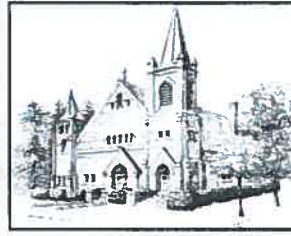

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

There are always good things to contemplate for our spiritual or intellectual life, whether that is reading philosophy, theology, or things on the spiritual life more directly. Many people have also found that spending time in "nature" has allowed them to contemplate God and marvel at His majesty and goodness as shown through His created works. For example, looking at a beautiful landscape, forest, or ocean can lead our minds back to true Beauty, God Himself.

This is true because God is the first cause of all creation. In every creature (not just living being, but all things that are created), there is therefore a trace of the Holy Trinity. Every creature bears the "fingerprints" of God, so to speak. By the very fact that something is created, it is, at least in that aspect, good. It also, therefore, is beautiful to some degree. This is partly why human beings have the greatest dignity in all creation: we are made in the image and likeness of God, given an intellect and a will, like God.

But this past week we were given images from NASA, taken from their new telescope, which revealed to us, again, the vastness, grandeur, and stunning beauty of this world God had created. Below is a picture of what is described in the quotation, and it is much better viewed in color along with the other images (<https://www.nasa.gov/webbfirstimages>):

"NASA's James Webb Space Telescope has delivered the deepest and sharpest infrared image of the distant universe so far. Affectionately known as Webb's First Deep Field, this is galaxy cluster SMACS 0723 and it is teeming with thousands of galaxies – including the smallest, faintest objects ever observed.



Webb's image is approximately the size of a grain of sand held at arm's length, a tiny sliver of the vast universe. The combined mass of this galaxy cluster acts as a gravitational lens, magnifying more distant galaxies, including some seen when the universe was less than a billion years old. This deep field, taken by Webb's Near-Infrared Camera (NIRCam), is a composite made from images at different wavelengths, totaling 12.5 hours – achieving depths at infrared wavelengths beyond the Hubble Space Telescope's deepest fields, which took weeks. And this is only the beginning. Researchers will continue to use Webb to take longer exposures, revealing more of our vast universe.

This image shows the galaxy cluster SMACS 0723 as it appeared 4.6 billion years ago, with many more galaxies in front of and behind the cluster. ...Light from these galaxies took billions of years to reach us."

It is impossible to comprehend the vastness of God's creation. When we see images such as this we should be reminded that the Beauty of God Himself is infinitely more than even those stunning pictures of God's creation. And His Love for us extends beyond the furthest reaches of the universe. We can catch a glimpse of God through His created works, but the beauty of creation should always remind us to strive after the goal of eternal glory Heaven, where we will see God as He truly is, Beauty Itself, face-to-face.
