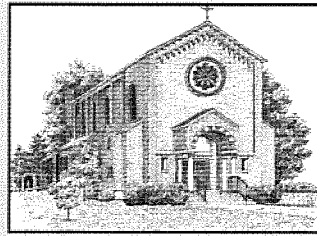
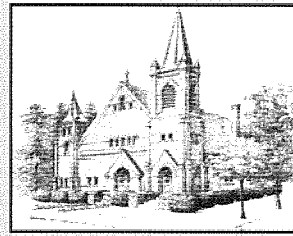


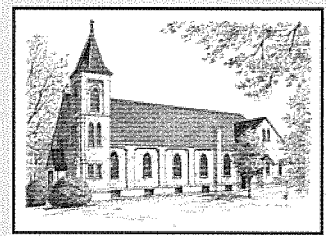

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

This week, on August 4, we celebrate the Memorial of St. John Vianney (born Jean-Baptiste-Marie Vianney; May 8, 1786 – August 4, 1859). He is often referred to as the Curé d'Ars, which simply means is the priest of the parish of Ars, France. In 1925, Pope Pius XI canonized him, and proposed, in 1929, that St. John Vianney be held up as the model for all parish priests.

Regarding his remarkable life, I want to give some details and encourage you to read some of his sermons and learn about various miracles worked through him. At the time he was sent to the parish in 1818, there were 230 people in the town. There was widespread ignorance and indifference to the Faith, the effects of the French Revolution. As the only priest there, it was his job to bring them back to the practice of the Faith. He went into bars on Sundays to get people to stop drinking and dancing, and to help them to fulfill their most basic obligation to worship God. A few years into his work at Ars, he founded a home for destitute girls called "La Providence." By teaching on all matters pertaining to faith and morals, and by his own example of an exemplary life, he won the hearts of so many of the people in his town.

When we look back on these years it is tempting to think his fame and popularity as a confessor and holy priest happened very quickly. While it is reported that by 1827 (9 years into his pastorate) people started to travel to him to seek counsel, and by 1855 there were an estimated 20,000 pilgrims each year coming to see him, that is a vast expanse of years relative to the life of a priest and of those living in the parish. This is the value of stability.

In the winter months, he would spend up to 12 hours each day hearing confessions. In the summer months he would hear confessions for up to 16 to 18 hours each day. He would take some breaks to pray his breviary, say Mass, and preach, but his love for souls was shown most clearly in his desire to heal the wounds of sin in the Sacrament of Confession. This is where his true priestly heart was most evident.

A few years ago, in 2018-2019, a relic of St. John Vianney toured our country. It was not just a piece of his hair or some small fragment of bone as most relics are. It was *his incorrupt heart that was put on display for all to see*. It was about forty-five years after his death that his heart was removed and found to be incorrupt. Isn't that fitting for the heart of a priest who truly shared all the same loves as the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus? Just as the heart of Our Lord beats forever for the love of each of us, so God has given us a sign of this eternal love: the incorrupt heart of a priest. It was through that heart, and his words and actions, that Jesus communicated His love and His sanctifying grace to countless souls who came to Ars seeking healing, peace, and union with God.

Pray for all priests, that our hearts may be formed by, and modeled on, the Sacred Heart of Jesus. St. John Vianney, pray for us!

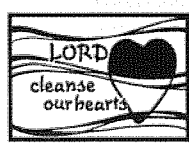

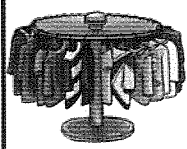

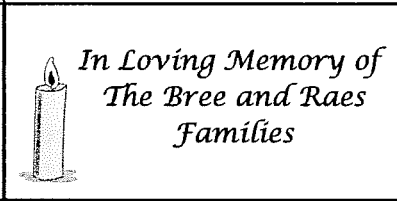
