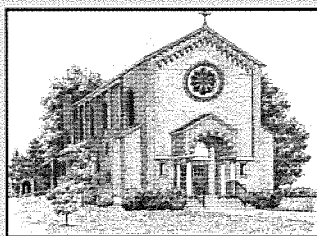


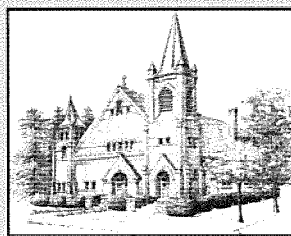

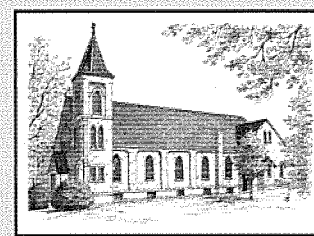

**FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO**

This week I simply want to share my joy with you from the Vocations Mass celebrated at St. Dominic on August 4, the Memorial of St. John Vianney. Fr. Aaron Kelly was the celebrant and preached a beautiful homily on the priesthood and the Heart of Christ. Throughout the course of the evening there were seven priests present. For me, the most impressive aspect of the evening, the most hopeful, and the most precious (besides the Mass), was seeing all the families. We welcomed families from various parishes – even some as far away as Elmira and Corning – to pray for vocations and spend time with some of the newer priests of the diocese.

The picnic was organized by Deacon Dermot and Janene Loughran. Deacon Loughran serves at St. Jerome Parish in East Rochester, but his family has been organizing and hosting such events for vocations for several years now. I am personally greatly in debt to them for their generosity, kindness, and overall support not only to me, but to all our priests and seminarians.

You will see a picture here with all the children present at the Mass and picnic. The picture consists of six priests, two seminarians, and many children. It was such a joyful evening of being together, celebrating vocations, and praying fervently for more young men to answer the call to the Priesthood and for our men and women to hear God calling them to the religious life. Besides much prayer, it is so important for young people to be around those who have answered this call and who live it joyfully and faithfully. That was the opportunity that these families present had that evening. I hope to continue this tradition of Masses for vocations in the coming years.

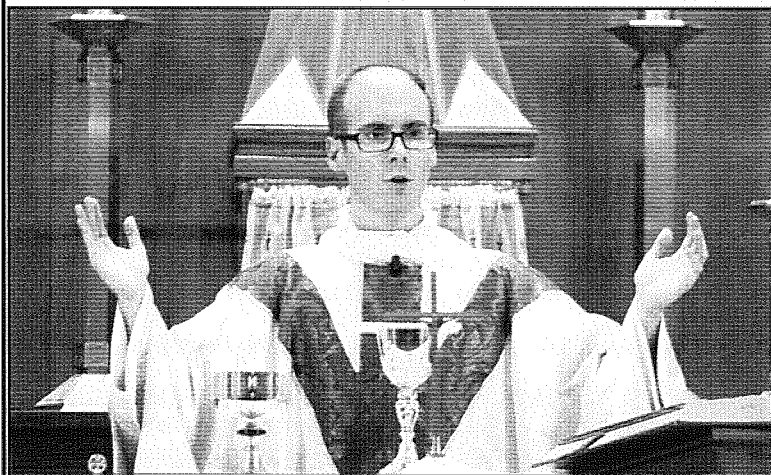

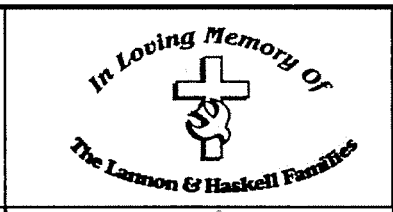

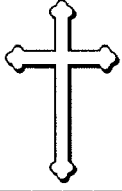
