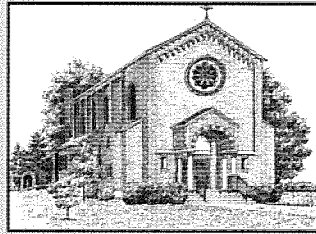


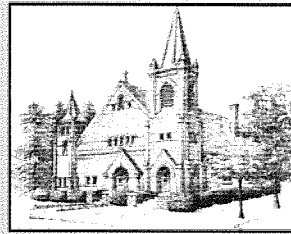

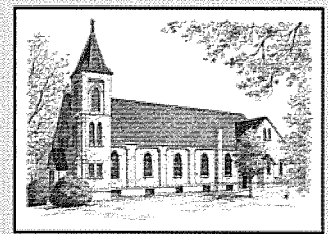

I went to bed on Monday evening, August 15, thinking, "That was one of the most beautiful weekends of my priesthood." I will consider the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary to be part of the weekend since it is one of the highest feast days of the year.

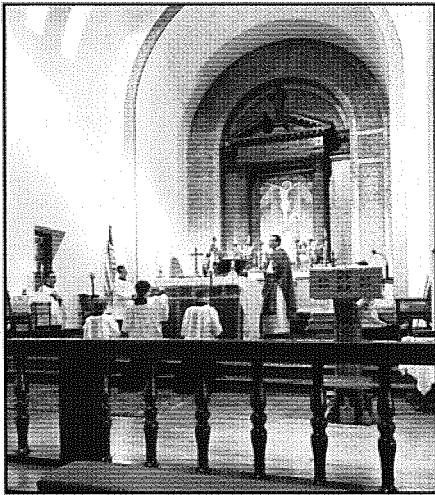
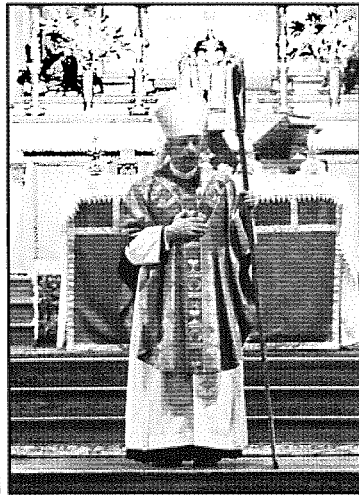
First, we had Bishop Matano come out to St. Francis Church to celebrate Mass for us. It is always a special occasion when our Shepherd can be with us in person to celebrate the Mass, the very act of worship that unites us to God and to one another (both in the parish and throughout the diocese). The bishop expressed to me how impressed he was with the families, the altar servers, the music, and everything else that went into that Mass on Sunday morning. Thank you to all who had a role in welcoming our bishop, whether at the Mass or the reception after the Mass. He told me to let him know when we would like him to come back to the parish and celebrate Mass again for us.

Besides the beauty of the Mass itself, I loved to see people from all three of our churches come to greet our bishop and worship together. It is such a joy to see a church that looks more full, expressing the unity of a single parish. I know on certain holy days, such as during the Triduum, this is common, but for a Sunday in Ordinary Time I am grateful to the people who may have had to change their normal schedule to come out to be with our bishop.

Second, the Masses for the Assumption of Mary were also very beautiful and even brought people from various parishes, near and far. We welcomed people from parishes throughout Monroe County, and even as far as Elmira and Corning for the Latin High Mass in the evening. Both of the Masses for the Assumption had their own special solemnity to them, and I believe Our Mother was pleased with the worship we gave to God in honor of her, as I continue to pray for her protection and for her care of our parish.

May the Immaculate Heart of Mary be our refuge!

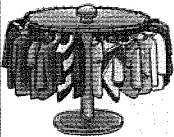

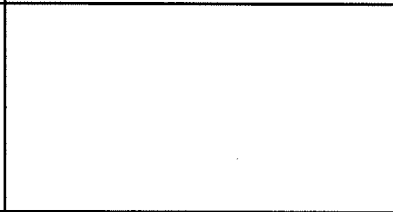
