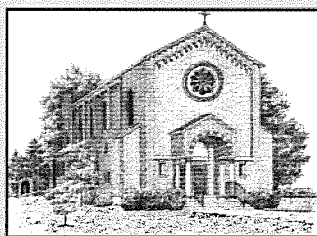


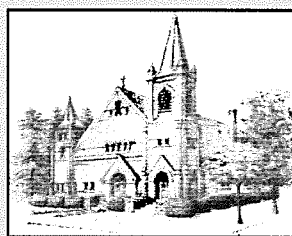

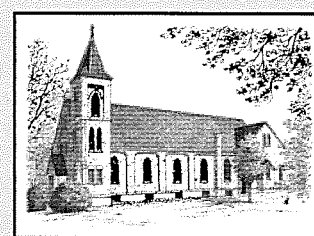

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

I wanted to write a few bulletin articles to discuss Sacred Music, its role in the liturgy, and what the Church teaches. There are actual norms for what the Church expects from the liturgy in the Roman Rite, and we are able to read about this, in the first place, in the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal*. The *General Instruction* (GIRM), is basically the instruction manual for the Mass. Perhaps when we buy some piece of electronic equipment, we just plug it in and figure it out as we go along, not bothering with the instructions. But if someone were to hand you a missal, you may ask, "How do I use this thing?" The GIRM tells you all you need to know, every liturgical act and gesture.

Even when it comes to music, we are told when to sing and what to sing. We are very fortunate to have a hymnal/missal in the pews that has all we need. It does not just have hymns, but all the other parts of the Mass as well, so that you can follow along. I have always found that reading along, as well as hearing, makes a big difference; not just for the readings, but for the Eucharistic Prayer, the Canon, as well. Being able to see the grammar of the prayers helps us understand its meaning. There are even prayers that the priest prays quietly that may be helpful to pray as well.

The entire Ordinary of the Mass is there as well. The *Gloria* that we typically sing is on page 33. The *Ordinary of the Mass* consists of all the parts that do not change. For example, the *Gloria*, the *Creed*, the *Sanctus* (Holy, Holy, Holy), and the *Lamb of God*, are the unchanging parts of the Mass (the *Gloria* and/or *Creed* are omitted at certain times). The *Propers of the Mass* are all those things that change for each specific Mass (Entrance Antiphon, Collect, Prayer over the Offerings, Offertory, Prayer after Communion).

Here are some of the basic norms on Sacred Music from the GIRM:

"40. Great importance should therefore be attached to the use of singing in the celebration of the Mass, with due consideration for the culture of peoples and abilities of each liturgical assembly. Although it is not always necessary (e.g., in weekday Masses) to sing all the texts that are in principle meant to be sung, every care should be taken that singing by the ministers and the people not be absent in celebrations that occur on Sundays and on Holydays of Obligation.

However, in the choosing of the parts actually to be sung, preference is to be given to those that are of greater importance and especially to those which are to be sung by the Priest or the Deacon or a reader, with the people replying, or by the Priest and people together.

41. The main place should be given, all things being equal, to Gregorian chant, as being proper to the Roman Liturgy. Other kinds of sacred music, in particular polyphony, are in no way excluded, provided that they correspond to the spirit of the liturgical action and that they foster the participation of all the faithful.

Since the faithful from different countries come together ever more frequently, it is desirable that they know how to sing together at least some parts of the Ordinary of the Mass in Latin, especially the Profession of Faith and the Lord's Prayer, according to the simpler settings."

There are footnotes given referring to the Second Vatican Council's Constitution on the Liturgy, *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, and other documents shortly after the Council. In the following articles I will go more into detail on what type of music the Church promotes, and music's place in the liturgy.


