

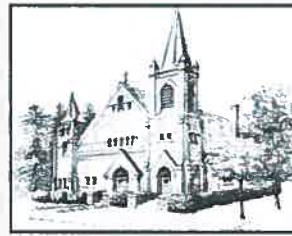

**FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO**



It is always a great joy to celebrate the patronal feast day of a church, and this week (August 8) we celebrate the Memorial of St. Dominic (AD 1170-1221), founder of the Order of Preachers, or more commonly known as the Dominicans. This is one of my favorite periods of history, the 13<sup>th</sup> century, for many reasons, particularly for the theological development that took place, but also the rise of the mendicant orders of the Dominicans and the Franciscans. God raises up the saints that are needed in every era of the Church. The vast majority of them are not known to the rest of the world. They are those who keep the faith and persevere to the end, live a holy life, receive the Sacraments, and walk humbly with God.

But God also raises up the great lights of the Church. He gives us those who the world will honor for the rest of time because of their faithfulness and because they responded to the special call God has given them. At the time of the early 13<sup>th</sup> century there was a dangerous heresy that was spreading from Southern France called Albigensianism. Their teaching was not essentially new in that it reiterated ancient Gnostic teachings which posited two gods, an evil god who created the material world, and a good god who created the spiritual world. It is a long story, but Dominic formed a group of preachers who would travel around seeking to convert people back to the Catholic Faith.

Both St. Dominic and St. Francis went to Pope Innocent III to seek permission for their new religious orders. To this day, both orders refer to each other's founder as "Holy Father." When, in 1216, Pope Honorius III gave permission for the new Order of Preachers, Dominic stayed in Rome and one day had a vision. Saints Peter and Paul appeared to him, handing him a staff and a book, and said: "Go and preach, because you have been chosen by God for this work."

You may notice on our beautiful statue of St. Dominic in our church that there is a dog at the base of the statue. This is a common feature of images of St Dominic. The reason is that Dominic's mother had a dream while she was pregnant with Dominic. She "had a dream of a dog with a torch in its mouth, running around the world and setting everything on fire. She went to the monastery of Santo Domingo de Silos and asked a monk what it meant. He replied that the child in her womb would be a great preacher, who would set the world ablaze with the fire of his words" (<https://www.catholicnewsagency.com/news/41982/st-dominic-a-dog-and-divine-fire>). The very name "Dominican" is a combination of the Latin words *Domini canis*, "the hound of the Lord."

Finally, we see in that statue at our church Mary personally handing the Rosary to St. Dominic to spread throughout the world. Mary appeared to St. Dominic and told him: "I want you to know that, in this kind of warfare, the battering ram has always been the Angelic Psalter which is the foundation stone of the New Testament. Therefore if you want to reach these hardened souls and win them over to God, preach my Psalter."

What is she talking about? The "Angelic Salutation" is when the Archangel Gabriel appeared to Mary at the Annunciation and greeted her, "Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with you." And the Psalter refers to the 150 Psalms in Scripture. Since the Old Testament foreshadows the New Testament and the New Testament fulfills the Old Testament, we can read Christ on every page of the Old Testament. By reciting the Joyful, Sorrowful, and Glorious Mysteries, we are praying 150 "Hail, Marys," matching the 150 Psalms that give us the Life of Christ. The Mother of God herself gave us the means of prayer to secure our souls for salvation. By meditating on the life of Christ, we should become more conformed to Him, and we see how it is through His Flesh that brought about the salvation of the world. Meditate about these mysteries of our faith every day and we will stay close to the hearts of Jesus and Mary.

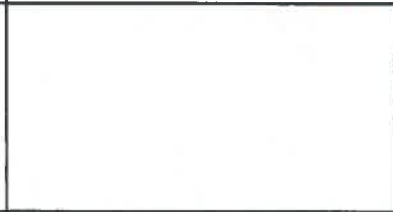

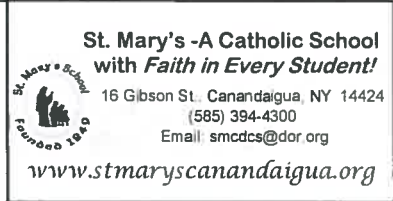
