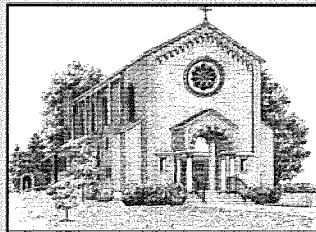
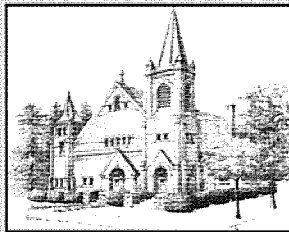


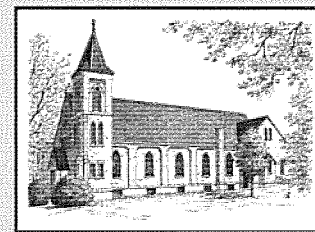

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Happy Easter to you all, as we complete the Octave of Easter this weekend. Divine Mercy Sunday completes for us the Easter Octave with a special emphasis on the Mercy of God, not only as part of Jesus' mission, but part of who He is as *the definitive incarnation of mercy*. This will be my fifth Divine Mercy Sunday as a priest, and every year I am amazed at the number of people that come out to the churches to celebrate this devotion, with such a beautiful desire to know the mercy of God. The lines for Confession are often very long, but that is often inspiring for those who may be hesitant to go to Confession.

Such devotion in so many people is the clear fruit of God's graces being poured out upon the world. The devotion to Divine Mercy can be seen as an amplification of the devotion to the Sacred Heart, or as the Sacred Heart devotion for this century.

For those still unfamiliar with this particular devotion, we look to the life of St. Faustina Kowalska who was a nun in the convent of the Congregation of Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy, in Poland, during the 1930s. She received many private revelations, messages, from Jesus that He had told her to write down. She also saw an image of Him with the rays of light coming from His Heart, which we are probably familiar with. The messages she received were recorded in her notebooks and then compiled into what is now known as the *Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska*, or simply as the *Diary*. I know this *Diary* has given great consolation and spiritual nourishment to so many.

St. Faustina was canonized on April 30, 2000 by Pope St. John Paul II. The Sunday of Divine Mercy was then instituted for the Second Sunday of Easter (the octave day). One example from the *Diary* shows our Lord telling St. Faustina of His desire for this new feast:

"On one occasion, I heard these words: My daughter, tell the whole world about My Inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come forth from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy." (*Diary* 699)

Besides the normal requirements to gain the plenary indulgence (sacramental confession within 20 days before or after the indulgenced work, Holy Communion on the day the work is done, prayers for the Pope's intentions, and complete detachment from sin), the prayers to be done to gain the plenary indulgence this day are:

In any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy

Or, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (such as, 'Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!').

We certainly have ample opportunity this Sunday afternoon, at St. Dominic's Church, to partake of this "ocean of graces" poured out upon the world during these devotions. For more information, go to <https://www.thedivinemercy.org>.




