

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

On this Memorial Day weekend, this last weekend of the month of May, in which we greatly honor Our Mother Mary, I want, first, to thank all the families and children who participated in our May Crowning last Sunday at St. Dominic. It was a beautiful procession in honor of Mary and her Queenship over our own lives and over our parish.

And so, I will complete this Month of Mary with further reflections from St. Louis de Montfort's True Devotion to Mary. This saint teaches us that perfect devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary is precisely what leads us to a perfect consecration to Our Lord Jesus Christ. He instructs us to hand over all the value of our good works, prayers, and satisfactions (prayers and actions done for the remittance of punishment due to sin) for her to do with as she pleases. By doing this, by this consecration to Mary, we are handing over everything that we have in complete trust in our Mother who pleads for us. Knowing that Our Lord will refuse her nothing for which she asks, we can have complete confidence that she will care for our merits and satisfactions, embellish them, and increase them by her own merits. In so entrusting ourselves to her, everything we are and have, we allow her to distribute the value of all our good actions in whatever way she chooses, and she has a will that is more perfectly united to Christ than any other creature.

Consecration to Mary is also a type of renewal of our baptismal promises. When we were baptized, it was most likely our parents and godparents who made those promises for us: to renounce the reign of Satan over us, to live according to the light of the Gospel, to profess the Faith in word and action. As we were given to God, in baptism, by the mouth of another (parents or godparents), now with our own mouth we may give ourselves to God through the hands of another: the Blessed Virgin Mary. Consecration to Mary allows us to live out these baptismal promises faithfully and with complete confidence in the divine assistance.

The effects of this devotion and consecration to Mary are profound. In short, we are made to be like Mary, the perfect disciple, and therefore close to Christ who sees us as His beloved children. The first effect is that we will come to see a true knowledge of ourselves. In giving us a portion of her profound humility, we see how lowly we are and how incapable we are of doing good apart from the grace of God. Second, we will share in Mary's faith, which was greater than all other humans combined. This virtue of faith in which we share allows us to see the world from the perspective of the glory of heaven that awaits us, and so the things we love are rightly ordered.

A third effect of such a consecration is that she will provide in our hearts a love that casts out fear of punishment and frees us from scruples and discouragement. We can relate to God as a loving Father and, like Mary, have a great desire to please Him alone. Related to this increase of faith, the fourth effect is a profound confidence in God and in Mary. She desires to clothe us in her virtues and merits, as any mother would desire to clothe her children. We do not approach our Lord alone, but it is she who holds us and carries us there. The more confidence we have in her, the less we have in ourselves and our own powers.

There are a few more specific effects that de Montfort relates to us. In short, we imitate Christ by imitating the perfect disciple: Mary. She loves each of us as we are her own children, and, given her highest favor with God – she being clothed in all virtue and grace – the closer we are to her, the closer she brings us to her Divine Son. This true devotion to Mary is not just for this month, but it is to be the model of our lives, for our sanctification, and for the greater glory of God.
