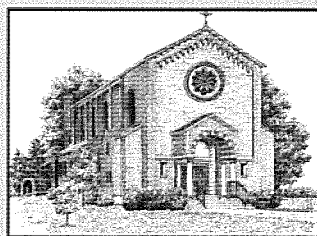
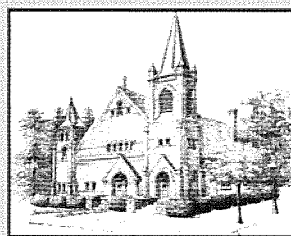


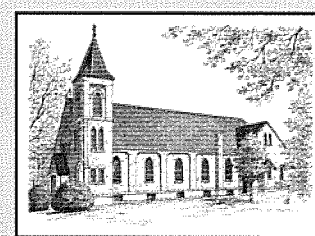

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

I cannot possibly thank you all enough for the cards, gifts, congratulations, and love you have given me on the occasion of my fifth anniversary of ordination to the Priesthood. It was a beautiful and memorable weekend with all of you, and I sincerely hope for many more years serving you at this parish. It has been one of the best years of my life and I will continue to give my life for you every day.

Now that we have arrived at the Sunday of the Most Holy Trinity, the Sunday after Pentecost, we enter into Ordinary Time. We celebrate this Sunday after just celebrating Pentecost because the reality of the Holy Spirit has just been revealed to us. The Holy Trinity is the central mystery of our Faith. Throughout history, God desired to reveal Himself to us so that we can know, love, and serve Him. We see the face of the Father in Jesus, and we have been given a share in the very life of God through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit onto the world and into our soul.

If this is the reality in which we live, why do we call this "Ordinary Time"? The Latin word *ordinalis* is used in reference to numbers in a series. It would be better to refer to it as "ordinal time" or "ordered time" as each week is successively numbered for thirty-four weeks. The season of Ordinary Time begins after the feast of the Epiphany until the beginning of Lent, then we pick it up again after Pentecost (this year, we resume with the Tenth Week in Ordinary Time). The season is characterized by a tour through the entire life and teachings of Christ in the Gospels and of St. Paul in his epistles.

Prior to the use of the current Roman Rite, beginning in 1970, the weeks after Pentecost were counted differently. They were simply referred to as weeks "after Pentecost." The weeks after Epiphany were referred to simply as weeks "after Epiphany." Besides the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter, all liturgical time was referred to the great events of the revelation of God in the world: Epiphany and Pentecost. Pentecost used to have an octave as well! Just as Easter has an octave followed by six more weeks, so with the octave of Pentecost, there were eight weeks total, making the Easter Season an octave of octaves.

The entire life of the Church is lived between the time of Pentecost and the consummation of the world, when Our Lord returns in glory. While the Church, Christ's Body sojourning on earth, goes through this only once, the individual soul must go through this cycle every year. We need the constant reminder of who we are, why we were made, how to live, and what our destiny is as a child of God. The liturgical life of the Church is the very pattern of our lives. It should form us and give us the material for our own meditation and prayer throughout each year.

As we make our approach towards *Corpus Christi*, the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, and we prepare for the procession where our Lord will lead us through the streets, we prepare our souls to follow Him wherever he may lead us in this life.

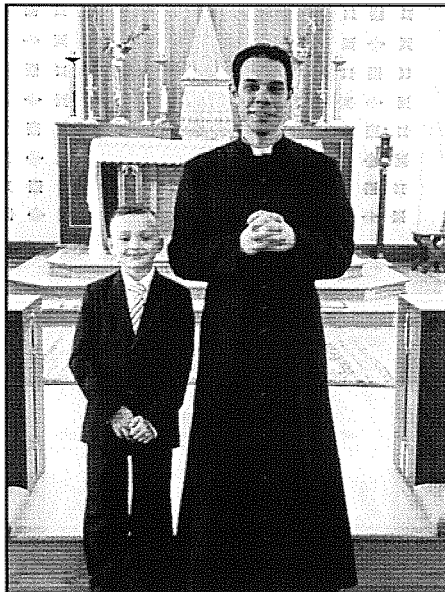
