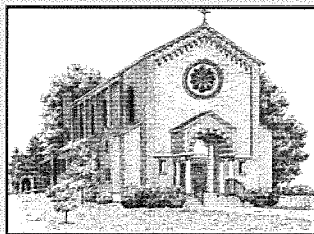


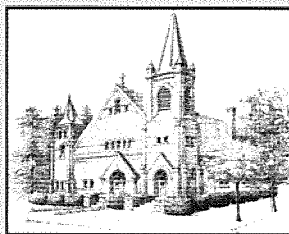

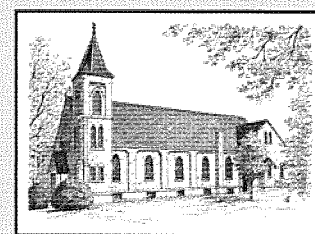

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Happy Pentecost! *Veni Sancte Spiritus!* Come, Holy Spirit! As we celebrate the "birthday of the Church" with great solemnity and joy, it is a good time to grow in our own devotion to the Holy Spirit and ask Him to perfect us with His gifts.

I am sure you have heard of the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit and the Twelve Fruits of the Holy Spirit. I want to briefly outline the Seven Gifts and what they do within us. First, it is important to recall the four Cardinal Virtues and the three Theological Virtues. All virtues that we can acquire through repeated good actions flow from the four cardinal virtues of prudence, justice, temperance, and fortitude. We can *learn* these virtues and *grow* in these virtues without sanctifying grace (theoretically). We all know people who have a lot of virtuous qualities but may not be believers in any way. This is because there is a certain kind of perfection that human beings can acquire, or at least tend towards, without striving for their *final end* of the glory of heaven.

Second, there are the three Theological Virtues: faith, hope, and charity. These virtues cannot be acquired by human effort, but they are directly infused into us at baptism initially. When we say that someone is in a "state of grace," we mean that they possess the infused virtues of faith, hope, and charity. As you have noticed, this adds up to seven virtues total. Coincidentally, there are seven gifts of the Holy Spirit which then further perfect these virtues.

If the virtues perfect our faculties (intellect and will), and rightly order our passions, appetites, and emotions, then why do we need the "gifts of the Holy Spirit"? The virtues are *our own actions*, guided by faith, aided by grace. The gifts of the Holy Spirit *are truly God's action within us*. The gifts *act upon* the soul as the soul is passive in receiving them. They allow the person to perform virtuous acts more easily, now that they have God working within them and the soul co-operating with God.

The gift of *Wisdom* perfects further the virtue of *charity*, which unites us to God directly. Wisdom allows us to see everything in relation to God and our eternal destiny in heaven. With this gift, all of our knowledge is ordered rightly towards the glory of God. The gift of *Understanding* perfects the virtue of *faith*. It allows us to have a deep, penetrating insight into the revealed truths of God.

The gift of *Counsel* perfects the cardinal virtue of *prudence*. While prudence allows us to judge rightly the course of action that should be taken to attain a certain end, even our supernatural end of heaven, the gift of Counsel provides the soul with a certain decisiveness and ease in making difficult decisions. The gift of *Fortitude* simply perfects the cardinal virtue of *fortitude*. This gift has a relation to all the virtues in that it allows one to undergo difficult and arduous tasks. Living a holy and virtuous life is difficult. Fortitude allows us to live a holy life, and the gift of Fortitude is what allowed the martyrs to persevere to the end.

The gift of *Knowledge* also perfects the virtue of *faith*. Whereas the gift of Understanding allows one to penetrate more deeply into the mysteries of revealed truth, the gift of Knowledge allows one to see created (natural) things in the light of our supernatural end or goal.

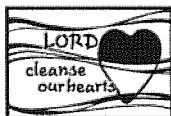
The gift of *Piety* perfects the cardinal virtue of *justice*. This gift allows us to be loving children of the all-loving Father. We want to give to our Father all that we can out of love for Him, but also because he is owed our worship. The perfection of piety is the virtue of religion, by which we give to God worship that is owed to Him. This gift also allows us to see everyone as our brother and sister out of this love for God that we have. Finally, the gift of *Fear of the Lord* perfects the theological virtue of *Hope*, and the cardinal virtue of *temperance*. This is not a *servile* fear that makes us run from God to avoid punishment. It is a profound respect and love of God that causes us to avoid sin, lest we lose God. As a perfection of temperance, this gift helps us regulate all sensual pleasure in order to avoid excess.

Let us enjoy the light and graces of the Holy Spirit who so desires to make His home within our souls. Pray to the Holy Spirit for these gifts...Come, Holy Spirit!


