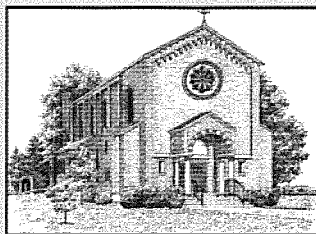
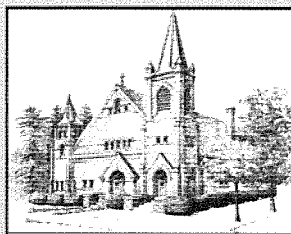


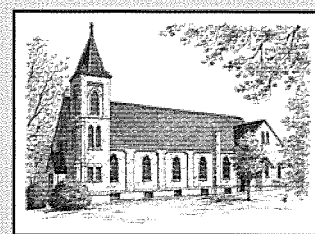

**ST. PETER'S ROMAN CATHOLIC PARISH at the CHURCHES of ST. DOMINIC, ST. FELIX, and ST. FRANCIS**

**FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO**

Two weeks ago, I began the discussion on St. Louis de Montfort's book *True Devotion to Mary*, specifically his section entitled "Fundamental Truths of Devotion to the Blessed Virgin." I want to continue this discussion, as we are still in the month of May, and so still focusing on our Marian devotion. As a reminder, the "First Truth" is that Jesus Christ Is the Last End of Devotion to Mary. The "Second Truth" is We belong to Jesus and Mary as Their Slaves.

The "Third Truth" is We Need Mary in Order to Die to Ourselves. With this truth, de Montfort lays out for us a brief picture of the corruption of our human nature (by original and actual sin) and our complete unworthiness to receive God's grace. Yet, while "[we] have nothing for our portion but pride and blindness of spirit, hardness of heart, weakness and inconstancy of soul, concupiscence, revolted passions, and sickness in the body," God chose to give us His Mother to be our Mother also. Such devotion to her will help us see the surest and most efficient way to perfection through the renunciation of ourselves. Jesus tells us: "Believe me when I tell you this; a grain of wheat must fall into the ground and die, or else it remains nothing more than a grain of wheat; but if it dies, then it yields rich fruit. He who loves his life will lose it; he who is an enemy to his own life in this world will keep it, so as to live eternally" (John 12:24-25). We can also think of it as St. Paul explains: "You must be heavenly-minded, not earthly-minded; you have undergone death, and your life is hidden away now with Christ in God" (Colossians 3:2-3). There is no one whose life was more "hidden with Christ in God" than the Blessed Virgin Mary.

The "Fourth Truth" is We Need Mary as Our Mediatrix with Our Mediator, Jesus Christ. This can be difficult for many because the question naturally arises: "Why can't I just go to Jesus directly?" Well, you can, as "there is only one God, and only one mediator between God and men, Jesus Christ, who is a man, like them" (1 Timothy 2:5). Jesus is our only access to the Father. Yet, because of Christ's majesty, His holiness, and our sinfulness, He has appointed mediators who pray and plead with Him on our behalf. In the actual order of things, the Son of God chose to come into the world through the womb of Mary. By giving us such a Mother, we go to Jesus through her. Like the light of the moon, she reflects the light of the Sun, and tempers it to our capacity. St. Bernard and St. Bonaventure spoke highly of Mary's intercession for us. And we are familiar with the great prayer, the *Memorare*: "Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help or sought thy intercession, was left unaided...." Christ does not refuse His mother's prayers for her beloved children!

Finally, the "Fifth Truth" is We Need Mary in Order to Preserve the Graces and Treasures We Have Received from God. St. Paul, again, reminds us that, "We have this treasure in earthen vessels" (2 Corinthians 4:7). This "treasure" is all the graces Our Lord has given us, to heal us, strengthen us, and preserve us in His love and friendship. We know all too well how fragile we are in this earthly life, how easily we can be robbed of this invaluable treasure because we rely on our own powers to preserve it. *We must entrust this treasure to Mary, in whom the serpent has never had part.* She will hold on to it for us; she will preserve it for us, in order to present us to her Son, clothed in those graces He has poured out upon us.


