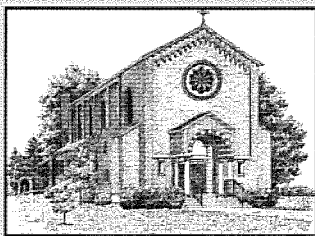
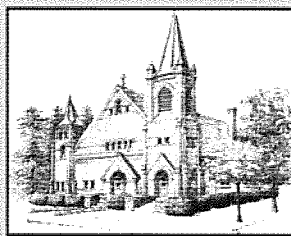


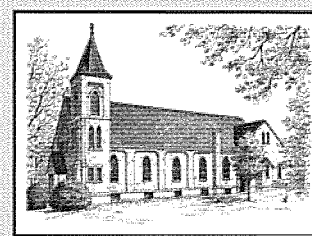

**ST. PETER'S ROMAN CATHOLIC PARISH at the CHURCHES of ST. DOMINIC, ST. FELIX, and ST. FRANCIS  
FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO**

As we now enter this month of May, we turn our attention to the beautiful devotions to the Blessed Virgin Mary that the Church has provided for us throughout the centuries. Of course, we pray to our Mother Mary throughout the year, but we take this month to give special attention to this devotion we have. Typically, this is expressed in churches with public rosaries or the recitation of the Litany of Loreto (Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary), and with the May Crowning ceremony. Besides these external devotions, we must also foster a true interior devotion and love for Mary and to allow her to lead us to her Son, Jesus.

In my own reading and prayer, the greatest work on Marian devotion is *True Devotion to Mary* by St. Louis-Marie Grignon de Montfort (1673-1716). (I have found that the one published by TAN Books is a good edition because it has a full program for the thirty-three day total consecration.) It has everything you will need to know about what, why, and how to live a life devoted to Mary.

In a couple bulletin articles I want to give you his five "Fundamental Truths of Devotion to the Blessed Virgin." The First Truth that St. Louis de Montfort gives to us is that "Jesus Christ is the Last End of Devotion to Mary." In this case, "last end" means "purpose" or "goal." So, we must always keep in mind that it is Christ, the Son of God, whom we adore. Our devotion to Mary allows us to live a better Christian life. If we establish in our life of prayer a true devotion to Mary, it is so that we may have a more perfect love of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is through devotion to Mary that we find "an easy and secure means for finding Jesus Christ."

The Second Truth that de Montfort shows us is that "We belong to Jesus and Mary as Their Slaves." The word "slave" may seem like a harsh word in reference to how we relate to Jesus and to Mary, but he lays out for us certain distinctions. In baptism, we have become slaves of Jesus Christ. We live, work, and die according to His will and we were allowed to become part of His Body, in baptism, so that we can bring forth fruit for Him, by our lives.

A servant can be seen as one who merely works for wages, as one who has set hours of work, and can leave that service at any given time without fault. A slave, on the other hand, is entirely dependent, in every aspect of his life, on the will of his master. Of the various modes of slavery, de Montfort says it is slavery of the will that is how we are united to Christ. The will is the highest part of our being, and the perfection of the will is the virtue of charity, love, which unites us to God directly. In this sense, we are to be loving slaves of Jesus Christ who desire to give everything for the honor of belonging to Him and pleasing Him.

The great saints, for example, St. Augustine and St. John Damascene, tell us that all that Jesus is and has *by nature*, Mary has been given *by grace*. They are one in will, united by grace, and so have the same subjects, servants and slaves, as St. John Damascene tells us. As St. Augustine reminds us, Mary is the means by which God chose to come to us, and so she is the means of which we must make use to go to Him. As de Montfort tells us: "Let us make ourselves, and call ourselves, slaves of Jesus Christ; for that is being the slave of the holy Virgin, inasmuch as Jesus is the fruit and the glory of Mary."

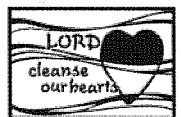

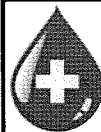


