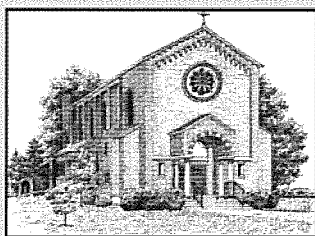
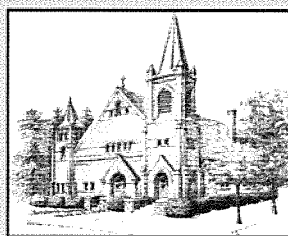


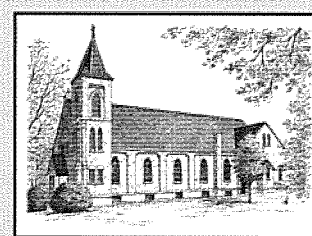

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO**

Happy Mother's Day to all mothers in our parish! Thank you for your sacrifices, example, and dedication in raising your children and handing on the Catholic Faith. Never underestimate the power of your prayers and example, whether your children are very young, or have long-ago moved out of the house. We are all bound together in this Body of Christ, but there is a unique bond between a mother and a child.

One of the most famous, and moving, relationships in the history of Christianity between a mother and her child is the relationship between St. Monica and her son St. Augustine. We may know a bit of their story and think, "Well, of course that turned out well...they're saints!" We are not born as saints, however. We all have to strive to live a life of holiness. St. Monica gave so much of her life for the conversion of her wayward son, Augustine. He was not baptized until he was thirty-three years old. Sure, he was catechized and baptized by the great St. Ambrose of Milan, but this was after many years of searching, and countless tears by Monica.

In St. Augustine's autobiography, *Confessions*, he describes his mother quite honestly. She was not perfect, and the picture given of her is not idealized. But she prayed and sacrificed much, despite her flaws and her pain. She could not see the workings of God's grace in her son's heart all those years. She knew she had to trust that God was in fact working and pouring out His graces upon Augustine. She was fortunate in her lifetime to see the results of so many prayers. A lot of us do not see such obvious results of our prayers, but we know the prayers of a mother hold a special place in the heart of God.

In this month of May, as we honor Mary, the Mother of God, our Mother, we remain close to her in confidence that God especially hears our prayers through her. Mothers can and should unite their prayers to the prayers of our heavenly mother, who constantly intercedes for all her children.

Finally, here is a brief reflection on the beauty of motherhood from Cardinal Jozef Mindszenty. Perhaps you have seen this before, but I am always reminded of it at this time of year. Cardinal Mindszenty led a heroic life that is worth reading about, but for now I leave you with a small section from his book *The Mother*:

"The most important person on earth is a mother. She cannot claim the honor of having built Notre Dame Cathedral. She need not. She has built something more magnificent than any cathedral – a dwelling for an immortal soul, the tiny perfection of her baby's body . . . The angels have not been blessed with such a grace. They cannot share in God's creative miracle to bring new saints to Heaven. Only a human mother can. Mothers are closer to God the Creator than any other creature; God joins forces with mothers in performing this act of creation . . . What on God's good earth is more glorious than this; to be a mother?"




