






FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

On September 30, 2019, the 1600th anniversary of the death of St. Jerome – the great biblical scholar and Doctor of the Church – Pope Francis instituted the "Sunday of the Word of God." He declared that the whole Church, on the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, will give special emphasis to the study and appreciation of the Divine Word of God given to us in the Scriptures.

Pope Francis' Apostolic Letter, *Aperuit illis*, begins with a line from the Resurrection appearance after the disciples on the road to Emmaus return to Jerusalem on Easter Sunday. Jesus shows the disciples His hands and His feet to prove that He is the same one they saw Crucified. He reminds them that He told them that everything in the Law of Moses, in the Psalms, and in the Prophets would be fulfilled. And it says that He then "opened their minds to understand the Scriptures" (Luke 24:45). The Pope's Apostolic Letter reminds us that "without the Lord who opens our minds to them, it is impossible to understand the Scriptures in depth" (*Aperuit illis*, 2). And so, it is fitting that this Letter was given on the feast day of St. Jerome who taught us that "Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ."

The Pope goes on to state that this time of year, in particular, "we are encouraged to strengthen our bonds with the Jewish people and to pray for Christian unity" (*Aperuit illis*, 3). This is true because of what Our Lord said above in Luke 24: everything in the Scriptures speak of Christ. In order to help us understand the Scriptures more, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops is offering a 5-video series on various aspects regarding the study and contemplation of Scripture. It begins this weekend! Here is the link to the page: https://catholic.bible/sunday-of-the-word-of-god/.

The Scriptures, inspired by the Holy Spirit, and free from all error, were given to us as part of the transmission of God's Word to His people. We may ask then: "But if Scripture is the 'Word of God' what else is God's Word?" We use the term "Word of God" in multiple ways. For example, Jesus is the Word of God, the Word of the Father, the Second Person of the Trinity Incarnate. Christ, as the Word of God, brought to us the full revelation of God and sent His Holy Spirit into the world who inspired the biblical writers. Prior to the actual writing of the texts that were then compiled into the Bible, these stories about Christ, who Jesus is, and the experiences that His earliest disciples had with Him, were shared orally by the preaching of the Apostles and by all who knew Christ. This teaching and preaching is the Tradition that has been handed on. Sacred Scripture is one of the sources to which we turn for knowledge of God as He has revealed Himself.

In his Apostolic Letter, Pope Francis makes frequent reference to *Dei Verbum*, the Second Vatican Council's Dogmatic Constitution on Divine Revelation, which clearly teaches the relationship between Scripture, Tradition, and the Magisterium of the Church. I highly recommend reading this document as well. You can type in 'Dei Verbum' into a search engine and it will take you to the Vatican's website. In order to keep this short, I can summarize by saying that a true Biblical Faith is based on the Word of God who has revealed Himself as the Incarnate Lord, Jesus Christ. Our Faith, therefore, as Pope Francis tells us in his Apostolic Letter "is based on the living word, not on a book (*Aperuit illis*, 11). This living word, expressed in Scripture and in tradition, is entrusted to the Church, governed by the Successors of the Apostles, to teach faithfully until Our Lord returns in glory.

I encourage you to take the time each day to read from God's Word in the Sacred Scriptures. Whether it is the readings for the day's Mass, or simply a single section from the Gospels, the more we allow those words into our minds and hearts, the more we will be conformed to Christ.






